

WHO MAY JOIN?

The Dance Competition is open to all ages nationwide. A dance teaser will be uploaded to NAPOLCOM Mascot Bantay's Facebook page from August 2 to August 23 2021.

 All NAPOLCOM officials, employees and volunteers and NCPW Technical Working Committee members, their immediate family and members of their households are not qualified to join the Competition.

RULES AND GUIDELINES

- Competitors shall choose their music and create an own version of the dance steps or choreography related to this year's NCPW theme, "Komunidad at Pamahalaan Magtulungan; Krimen, Korapsyon at Pandemya Labanan."
- The video shall have a minimum of three and maximum of five participants. It shall have a minimum running time of 90 seconds to a maximum of 3 minutes only.
- · Participants shall observe the safety health protocols on physical distancing.
- . Using of texts, props and other special effects shall be allowed provided that no obscenity of any form is shown.
- A panel of judges will select the winners based on the following criteria
 - Theme and Music (30%) -Musically beat techniques, timing and synchronization moves relevant to the theme
 - Performance (25%) -Staging, spacing, formation, execution, showmanship, projection stabilization and variety of routines
 - Choreography and Originality (20%) Dance arrangement, concept, and incorporating unique and original creative moves

Audience Impact (25%) - Number of Like, Wow and Love reactions,

REQUIREMENTS FOR SUBMISSION

- Entries must be submitted to <u>bantaynapolcom@gmail.com</u> with the subject 2021 NCPW Dance Competition and shall indicate the following details: Names of the contestants/participants, age, address or location, contact number and hashtag <u>#NCPWDanceCompetitionPH</u>.
- Entries shall be accepted from August 9, 2021 at 12:00 A M, up to August 23, 2021, 11:59 P.M.
- The qualified dance competition entries shall be posted on NAPOLCOM Mascot Bantay's Facebook (FB) page on August 24 to September 5, 2021.
- Once the dance challenge video entries have been posted, the public shall begin clicking their reactions. Only Like,
 Love and Wow reactions shall be counted for this contest.
- Cut-off date for reactions shall be on September 5, 2021 at 12:00 P.M and afterwards final tallying shall be conducted.
- Winning dance videos shall be announced in the NCPW Closing Ceremony on September 7, 2021.
- *For the People's Choice Award, the three (3) groups with the most "Likes", "Wows", and "Loves" will each receive \$3,000.00.

Only one form/entry per email shall be allowed.

The accepted jingle entries shall be posted on NAPOLCOM Mascot Bantay's Facebook

(FB) page on August 24 to September 5, 2021.

2021 NCPW JINGLE WRITING COMPETITION - MECHONICS

WHO MAY JOIN?

Competition is open to all amateur Filipino jingle writers.
All employees and volunteers of the NAPOLCOM and NCPW TWC and their immediate family and members of their households are not qualified to join the contest.

RULES FOR DISQUALIFICATION

An entry must not have been previously or recently licensed to any publisher, printed and distributed in hard copy or circulated through the Internet.

It must not have been previously recorded for commercial purposes or performed live in any venue such as concert halls or school auditorium, traditional radio and television, or posted on the Internet or recorded on video or any other format.

RULES AND GUIDELINES

Competition theme is "Kabahagi ang Lahat sa Paghadlang ng Krimen" (Crime Prevention is Everybody's Concern)

·Musical style must be up-tempo, current, bright and inspiring

Lyrics should have easy recall.

A panel of judges shall select the winners based on the following

- Originality: (20%) fresh sound, unique
- Musical content: (30%) melody recallLyrical content: (30%) coherence, ingenuity
- Overall impact: (20%) total effect on an audience will be based on number of reactions: Wow, Heart and Likes
- The jingle may be written and arranged in a popular or new song genre or a fusion thereof, in any form or structure by a sole composer or a maximum of five individuals which will be treated as one contestant under a group name.
- Duration of each entry should not exceed two minutes and have the capacity to be abbreviated into 30 to 60-second versions.
- · Lyrics may be Tagalog or Taglish
- Entries must be entirely original and should not infringe on any existing copyright or any other intellectual property rights.
- Any musical instrument can be used as accompaniment
