Abstract Submission:

Abstract within 250-300 words should be submitted to https://forms.gle/MRUYn9BFV4WSxBfH6 and must contain the following sections:

- 1. Title of the article
- 2. Name of the authors (All capital letters for the name of the presenter and normal case letters for the co-authors.)
- 3. Name of Presenter (1 only)
- 4. Affiliation and Business Address
- 5. Track
- 6. Email address
- 7. Content must contain the following: Novelty, objectives of the study, methodology, significant findings, and implication of the findings to technological, cultural and societal advancements.
- 8. Keywords (3-7 alphabetically arranged)

These should be typed single-spaced, Times New Roman with a font size of 12.

Full Paper Submission:

- 1. The final paper should follow the prescribed template of the journal with the following sections:
 - a. Title of the Paper
 - b. Name of Author/s
 - c. Affiliation
 - d. Email address
 - e. Content includes: Introduction, Materials and Method, Results and Discussion, Conclusion and Recommendation, Acknowledgement (if any) and References. Please find attached paper
- 2. Final papers should be submitted electronically in MS Word using the official paper template to the Committee via email. Deadline for submission of full papers will be on AUGUST 15, 2021.
- 3. An acknowledgement email will be sent to the presenting author upon receipt of the final paper.
- 4. All submitted full papers will be evaluated for the selection of best conference papers based on the following criteria:

Academic Significance	25%
Contribution to the Community	25%
Technical Novelty	20%
Quality of Information	25%
Language Usage	5%

5. The final paper is also necessary for submission if the research article is intended for publication to ASEAN Citation Index Journals. Submitted papers will be reviewed for adherence to established rules, scientific content and presentation by the Screening Committee. Original papers not yet published or currently under consideration for publication elsewhere can be submitted for publication.



Oral Research Presentation Guidelines:

- Research papers for parallel sessions will be of 10 minutes duration of recorded video and must be submitted to the committee through Google Drive on or before AUGUST 30, 2021.
- 2. The presentation must have a video dimension of 1280 x 720 (720p) using .mp4 format.
- 3. The research presenter must be present during the Academic Exchange after all videos had been presented.
- 4. This is the set of criteria for the Selection of Best Research Presenter



Mastery of the topic and organization of ideas. Demonstrate extensive knowledge of the topic.	25%
Language use, delivery and confidence. (Communicates ideas effectively)	25%
Quality of video presentation (Clarity of audio and video)	25%
Power point presentation. (Use of graphs and images)	25%
Total	100%

Infographic Research Presentation:

- Infographic is another way of communicating information or research findings to different people through social media platforms like Facebook, Instagram or Twitter to reach wider audience.
- 2. Qualities of effective infographics:
 - a. Takes not more than 30-40 seconds to read.
 - b. Presents data accurately and ethically.
 - c. Reference sources with citations.
 - d. Respect for cultural diversity.
 - e. The infographics must include the title of the research, name of author/s, affiliation, significant findings through visual and textual presentation and references (if any).
 - f. Size of the infographic must be in .png format.
 - g. This is the set of criteria for the selection of Best Infographic Research Presentation.

CRITERIA	PERCEN
CONTENT – Accurate and detailed information is provided and supports the thesis/argument/purpose	30%
VISUAL APPEAL - Fonts, colours, layouts, visual elements meaningfully contribute to the infographics' ability to convey the overall message	40%
ORGANIZATION – Information is systematically organized and supports reader's comprehension and the main message	20%
FOCUS - All content (visual and textual) concisely complements the purpose of the infographics	10%
