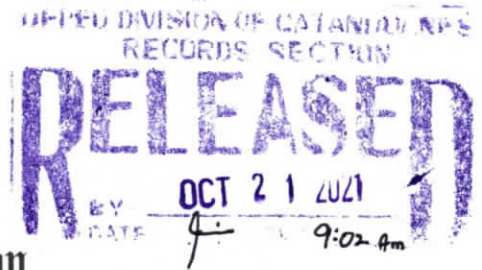

What is Global Media and Information Literacy (MIL) Week?

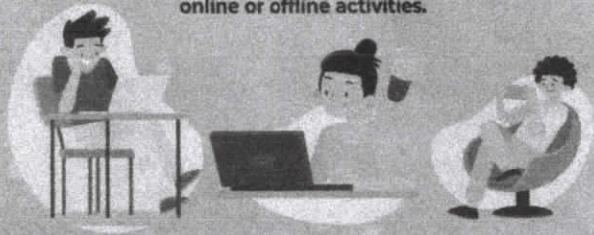


The 10th Global MIL Week theme is "Media and Information Literacy for the Public Good." The celebration will be hosted by South Africa from October 24-31, 2021.
