GENERAL GUIDELINES

1. Composition of the School Delegation

- Each delegation to the Division Technolympics shall consist of the following :
 - Secondary –
 - School Head / TLE Department Head
 - TLE/TVL Coordinator/Teachers/Coaches/Trainers
 - Official Student-contestants
 - ALS & SPED pupils
 - Elementary –
 - Public Schools District Supervisor as Head of the delegation
 - School Heads
 - EPP/TLE Key School Heads
 - EPP/TLE Coordinators/Teachers/Coaches/Trainers/support staff
 - Official pupil-contestants
 - ALS & SPED Teachers/Pupils

2. Requirements during the Technolympics

- a. All contestants and officials coaches are required to submit the following to the registration committee on or before October 9, 2019 :
 - School Principal's certification of the contestant's enrolment during the present school year with LRN
 - School Principal's certification of the Official coach as permanent teacher of the school
- b. Contestants are required to bring their own contest supplies, materials and tools/equipment except those will be provided by the organizers as agreed and listed in the additional guidelines.
- c. All contestants shall wear a white shirt (no Print/name of school) during the contest proper and /or PPE.

3. Solidarity Meeting

- a. Contestants, including coaches are required to attend the briefing with the Contest Administrators as scheduled. Questions shall only be entertained during the briefing.
- b. Agreements made outside of the contest package shall not be binding except upon approval of the Technical Committee.
- c. All questions during the briefing shall be noted and reported by the contest administrator to the Executive Committee.

4. Each municipality should bring Municipal Flag/Banner for hoisting during the opening
5. Each district/sec. school may wear T-shirt/uniform (if preferred)
6. Meals of participants, contest supplies, materials, tools & equipment shall be borne by the competing districts/schools.
7. Participants should bring their own beddings.

Additional Guidelines

Elementary :

1. Invitation Card Making –
Each contestant should bring their own laptop, printer, and special paper – long size (any color)
2. Dish & Gardening and Fruit & Vegetable carving – stick to the national guidelines as to the mechanics of administration.
3. Each contestant should wear PPE according to the standard requirements.

Secondary:

1. Beauty Care -
Each school will provide their own model (who may also join in the Search for Ms. Technolympics)
2. Dressmaking –
There shall be one model for each contestant to be provided by the host school.
3. Landscape Installation – all materials should be provided by the participating school. (Note: the school may coordinate to the host as regards Resource Requirements. (if preferred)
4. EIM – each participating school will bring all resource requirements including installation board.
5. Bazaar – one booth by district in the case of elementary and one booth per secondary school.

NOTE:

Please take note that the contest packages issued are the guidelines for the National Technolympics. Please disregard "Part III (Resource Requirements)" which indicates that the host school will provide the materials listed. As agreed, resource requirement shall be provided by the participating schools/districts.

Other details remain unchanged.

REMINDER:

Members of the technical/working committees, and event administrators are required to be at the venue on Day 0 for preparation and final instruction/briefing.
