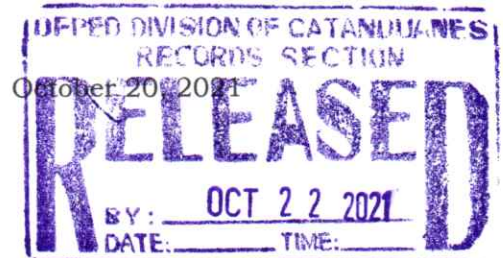

- Most Outstanding Teacher-Coach Award
A teacher-coach employed in a school institution that train students in at most 3 different year levels and accumulates 20 points based from the awards received by his/her students per competition.
