The Lee Kuan Yew School of Public Policy (LKYSPP) of the National University of Singapore invites applicants to enroll in the following Master degree programmes.

LKYSPP offers the following master programmes for AY 2019-2020:

- **Two-year Master in International Affairs (MIA):** For professionals with a keen interest in Asian and global affairs and with a strong passion to contribute to the positive transformations worldwide.
- **Two-year Master in Public Policy (MPP):** For early-career professionals with at least two years of relevant work experience, with an aim to gain a strong foundation in policy analysis, programme evaluation and management.
- **One-year Master in Public Administration (MPA):** For mid-managerial professionals with at least five years of relevant work experience, who aspire to make a transition to senior management and leadership roles through an intensive and interdisciplinary training in decision making and problem solving.

DepEd Philippines personnel should be officially nominated before proceeding with the online application. This is to ensure that the candidates are applying with the support of the organization, and have met the necessary requirements to be granted their study leave.

Scholarships are offered to candidates who are able to prove their merit through past academic performance and outstanding work experience. The scholarship application has been integrated into the online application form. Candidates would need to receive an offer of admission to the programme before they are considered for scholarship.

Further information on these courses are at www.lkyspp.nus.edu.sg/admissions. Places in the programmes and scholarships are offered on a competitive basis. The deadline for application for Master degree programmes is 14 December 2018 for the academic year commencing August 2019.

Each region is advised to nominate one (1) candidate for each program. Regional nominees are required to accomplish the online application and submit their documents through deped.in/lky2019 on or before the set deadline.
