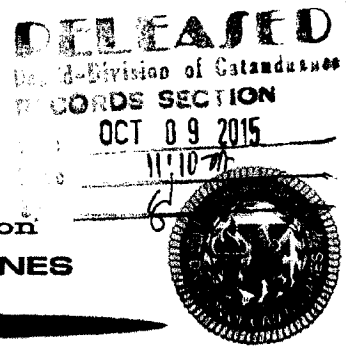



Likewise, School and Municipal Elimination Schedule, deadline of submission of Ora Pieces and Guidelines are attached for references.

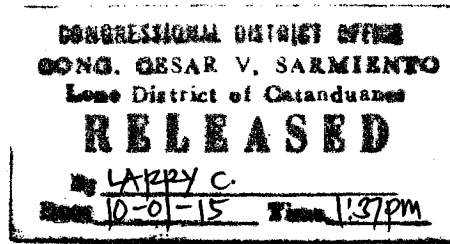

Dear Supt. Guemo:

Warmest greetings!

We are glad to inform you that preparations for the 15<sup>th</sup> Staging of the Atty. Cesar V. Sarmiento Oratorical Cup is already underway, and the Organizing Committee has set 11 December 2015 as contest day. We have also chosen the Provincial Capitol Dome as its venue.

For this year's contest, we picked the topic: "DOLE-OUT MENTALITY VERSUS ACCOMPLISHMENT-DRIVEN PUBLIC SERVICE: HOW WILL THEY INFLUENCE OUR VOTES IN THE COMING POLLS?" We believe said topic will be relevant as we approach the election year of 2016.

Since contestants will come from high schools all over the province, may we again respectfully coordinate this with your good office, particularly through the Office of the Education Program Supervisor for English, as we came up with the following schedule:

- School and Municipal Elimination Schedule: **October to November, 2015;**
- Deadline for submission of Municipal Finalists and their Ora Cup pieces to Organizing Committee/Congressional District Office: **02 December 2015.**

Per our Ora Cup Guidelines, except for Virac, the ten (10) municipalities will each be represented by one (1) contestant, so that high schools have been invited to participate in the elimination phase to determine municipal representatives. For Virac, we have reserved one slot each for CNHS, CC High School Department, CSU Laboratory Schools, Immaculate Conception Seminary Academy, and one slot for the clustered National High Schools of Antipolo, Calatagan, Hawan, Magnesia, Palta, and Buyo Integrated School.





Similar to the previous years' staging, we have also already identified the lead schools for the elimination phase.


We would thus like to earnestly request for your usual partnership on this program particularly in the monitoring of participation of our invited public high schools.

Attached herewith are the guidelines and the list of schools we have invited for the 15<sup>th</sup> Staging of the Cesar V. Sarmiento Oratorical Cup.

Anticipating your most favorable consideration upon this noble undertaking, we are.

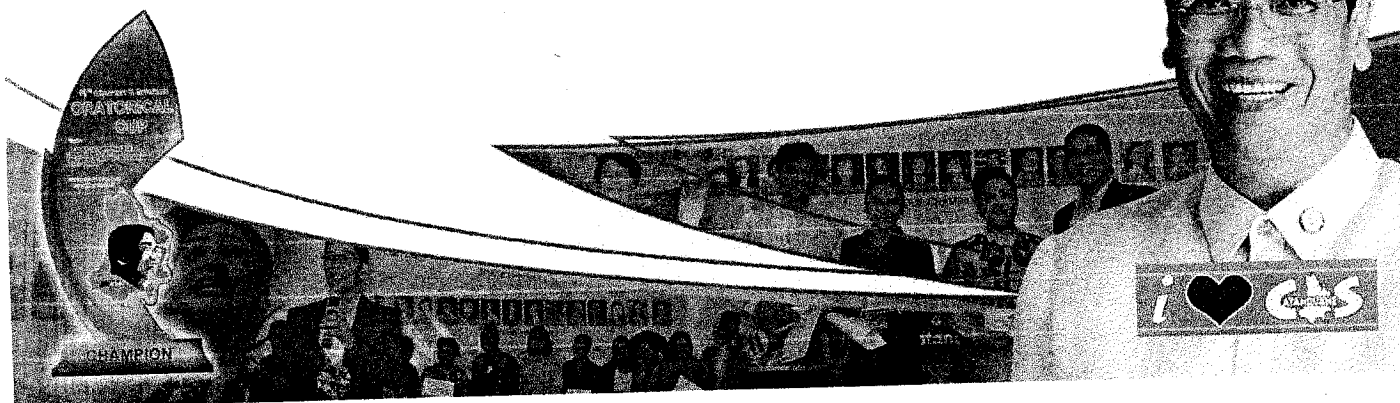

# 15<sup>th</sup> Cesar V. Sarmiento Oratorical Cup

## GUIDELINES:

1. The Oratorical Cup is open to all bonafide high school students in the province.
2. The oratorical piece shall be on the topic: **"DOLE-OUT MENTALITY VERSUS ACCOMPLISHMENT-DRIVEN PUBLIC SERVICE: HOW WILL THEY INFLUENCE OUR VOTES IN THE COMING POLLS?"**
3. Delivery shall be from five (5) to seven (7) minutes only.
4. Attire of the participants shall be semi-formal; no school uniform is allowed.
5. Participants shall be defined by numbers, to be determined through drawing of lots at the start of the competition.
6. The following are the criteria for judging:

### A. Content 30%

11. Schools represented by the participant shall be given Certificates of Appreciation.
