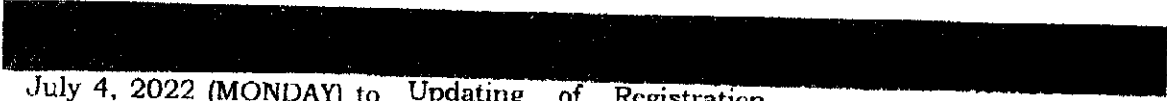

RESOLUTION NO. 10831

Pursuant to the powers vested in it by the Constitution of the Republic of the Philippines, the Omnibus Election Code (R.P. Blg. 881), Republic Acts 6646, 8189, 9164, 10742, 10952 and other election laws, the Commission on Elections (Commission), **RESOLVED** to prescribe the following calendar of activities and periods of prohibited acts in connection with the December 5, 2022 Synchronized Barangay and Sangguniang Kabataan Elections (BSKE):



July 4, 2022 (MONDAY) to July 23, 2022 (SATURDAY) Updating of Registration Records

1. Deactivation;
2. Inclusion/Exclusion;
3. Correction/editing of wrongfully encoded/lacking/mis-pelled names of voters in the VRS vis - a - vis those reflected in the COMELEC Precinct Finder;
4. Deletion of names of voters in the VRS duly

approved by the *En Banc* (manually crossed - out in the EDCVL and PCVL); and

5. Recapturing of Corrupted Biometrics

This Resolution shall take effect on the seventh (7th) day after its publication in two (2) daily newspapers of general circulation in the Philippines.

Using the voter's affidavit of another for the purpose of voting, whether or not he actually succeeds in voting. [Sec. 261 (y) (10), OEC].

Destroying, substituting, or taking away from the possession of those having legal custody thereof, or from the place where they are legally deposited, any election form or document or ballot box which contains official ballots or other documents used in the election. [Sec. 261 (z) (12), OEC]. **(NOTE: May be committed before or even after election day)**

Counting and canvassing of votes and proclamation of winning candidates immediately after closing of polls. Voting more than once or in substitution of another (Sec. 261 (z) (2) and (3), OEC).

Soliciting votes or undertaking any propaganda for or against any candidate within the polling place or within thirty (30) meters thereof. (Sec. 261 (cc), (6), OEC).

Selling, furnishing, offering, buying, serving or taking intoxicating liquor, etc. (Sec. 261, (dd), OEC).

Opening of booths or stalls for the sale, etc. of wares, merchandise or refreshments within thirty (30) meters radius from the polling place (Sec. 261, (dd) (2), OEC).

Giving, accepting free transportation, food, drinks and things of value (Sec. 89, OEC).

Holding of fairs, cockfights, boxing, horse races or similar sports (Sec. 261 (dd), (3), OEC).

Last day to file Statements of Contributions and Expenditures (SOCE) (Sec. 14, R.A. 7166).
