3. QUALIFICATIONS FOR PARTICIPATION ARE AS FOLLOWS:

A. SCOUTS

- Must be 11 years old or not over 17 years of age
- Must be physically fit as certified by a registered physician
- Must have sufficient camping experience (with camporal, provincial jamboree)
- Must have parent"s /guardian permit
- Must be equipped with camping gears
- Must be duly registered

B. SCOUTERS

- Must be duly registered
- Must be currently trained and have served as Unit Leader at least 2 years
- Must be of good moral character
- Must be equipped with camping gears

4. MODE OF TRANSPORTATION & MANNER OF DEPARTURE

The entire delegation will take the Calixta Ferryboat from San Andres Pier to Tabaco City Port on November 21, 2016 at 8:00 oclock in the morning.

All delegates must be at BSP Office at 5:00 AM with their Unit Leaders and ready for the roll Call at 6:00 AM . Exact departure timeat 7:00 in the morning.

- 5. A total deposit fee of FIVE HUNDRED PESOS (p500.00) representing a Reservation Fee and must be paid at Local Council on or before October 18,2016 to ensure acceptance of application. 

A Reservation Fee of Four Hundred pesos (PhP 400.00) shall be remitted/deposited directly to the account of the Iriga City Council, together with the roster of participants on or before 20 October 2016.
