- 1. In line with Section 43 Article IV of Republic Act. 9165 known as the "Comprehensive Dangerous Drug Act of 2002", the Department of Education demonstrates its support to the war against drugs of the government by revitalizing National Drug Education Program (NDEP). NDEP is a comprehensive educational program which provides for a holistic approach to the problem of drug abuse. In this regard, this Office will conduct a **Two-day Re-Orientation Seminar on National Drug Education Program** on **November 7-8, 2016**, **venue to be announced later.**
 - 2. Objectives of this activity are:
 - Re-orient the participants of the National Drug Education Program (NDEP) implementation in the schools;
 - Integration of Drug Education in the K to12 Curriculum;
 - Inform the School Heads that activities related to drug abuse prevention be included in School Improvement Plan
- 3. Participants to this activity are the *PSDS*, *Secondary School Heads*, *Elementary Central School Heads*, *District Guidance Coordinators*, *SGOD Health & Nutrition Section Personnel*, *CHNS Dentist*, *Nurse & Dental Aide*, *BATO RDHS Nurse*, *Palta NHS Nurse & District ALS Coordinator*.
- 4. Transportation expenses and Registration Fee of Five Hundred Pesos (250 per day) per participants to cover lunch and snacks is chargeable against schools MOOE/ local funds, while training materials will be charged against HRTD funds, subject to the usual accounting, auditing rules and regulation.
