DIVISION KINDERGARTEN FESTIVAL OF TALENTS IN BOTH PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SCHOOLS

**To: CID Chief
 Education Program Supervisors
 Public Schools District Supervisors
 Elementary & Pre-School Heads (Public and Private)

1. The SDO Catanduanes through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) will hold the **Division Kindergarten Festival of Talents in both Public and Private Schools on January 31, 2019** in a venue to be announced later.
2. The activity aims to:
 - a. showcase the potentials of kindergarten pupils to enhance their confidence and self-esteem;
 - b. strengthen the standards and quality of Kindergarten Education Program (KEP); and
 - c. ensure that the seven developmental domains of kindergarten which are not limited to health, well-being and motor development, socio-emotional development, values development, aesthetic/creative development, language, literacy and communication, Mathematics, understanding the physical and natural development are being developed.
3. The contest categories are the following:
 - a. Nursery Rhyme
 - b. Draw and Tell
 - c. Vocal Solo
 - d. Folk Dance
 - e. Story Telling (Wordless picture book)
4. The conduct of the school, district and municipal contest will be done on the following dates specified below and will be managed by the respective PSDS, while for the Private Schools it will be managed by the Private Schools Association.

5. A registration fee of Php 300.00 per contestant and coach, transportation and other incidental expenses relative to the conduct of this activity shall be charged against the school MOOE, school funds, PTA/ other funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
6. The different working committees and contest administrators will have a planning conference on December 10, 2018, 8:00 AM at CID.
7. The general guidelines, working committees and criteria are found in Enclosure No. 1 and 2.
8. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.

GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR THE CONDUCT OF THE DIVISION KINDERGARTEN FESTIVAL OF TALENTS IN BOTH PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SCHOOLS

1. Each Municipality will send one contestant to each category.
2. Participants to this competition are currently enrolled kindergarten pupils in both public and private schools aged 5 years old as of June 1, 2018 and will turn 6 years old until March 31, 2019.
3. A contestant is allowed to participate in only one category.
4. Only the municipal champion or the first place winners per category are qualified to join the contest in the Division level.
5. The private schools will be given one slot during the contest and only the champions per category are qualified to join in the competition.
6. The order of the presentation will be pre-determined by drawing of lots.
7. Coach in each category is required to submit contestant's birth certificate.
8. Mechanics in the conduct of the contest per category is to be followed strictly.
9. Top Five (5) winners shall be declared through ranking system:
 - * OVERALL CHAMPION
 - * First Runner-Up
 - * Second Runner-Up
 - * Third Runner-Up
 - * Fourth Runner-Up.
10. Total points garnered by each municipality shall be consolidated to get the overall champion.

11. The board of judges shall be composed of a Chairman and two members. The decision of the board of judges is final using the Ranking System.

NURSERY RHYME RECITATION

1. There shall be a uniform contest piece to be adopted.
2. Each contestant shall be given 3 minutes to deliver the piece.
3. The winner shall be chosen based on the criteria below.

CRITERIA:

- A. Mastery of Piece-----50%
 - B. Voice Projection/ Verbal style----- 20%
 - C. Expression/ Distinct Style-----20%
 - D. Level of confidence-----5%
 - E. Costume-----5%
- 100%**

DRAW and TELL

1. Materials to be used will be provided by the contestants.
 - Oslo paper (short)
 - Pencil
 - Crayon
2. Each contestant will be given 60 minutes to finish the drawing based on the theme of the festival.
3. Each contestant will be given 3 minutes to present (tell about) his/her drawing.
4. The winner will be chosen by the panel of judges based on the following criteria:

CRITERIA:

- A. Relevance to the Theme ----- 40%
 - B. Color Harmony/ Neatness----- 25%
 - C. Presentation of Concept/Idea-----15%
 - D. Originality of Idea-----20%
- 100%**

VOCAL SOLO

1. The contestant is free to choose his/her own piece, preferably Tagalog song suited to his/ her age.
2. The criteria for judging are as follows:

CRITERIA:

A. Voice quality	50%
B. Interpretation	25%
C. Stage Deportment	20%
D. Audience Impact	<u>5%</u>
	100%

FOLK DANCE

1. Each group is composed of 10 members only.
2. Five minutes (including entrance and exit) shall be allotted for each group to showcase their skills in folk dancing.
3. The winner shall be chosen based on the following criteria:

CRITERIA:

A. Synchronization of Movement	60%
B. Choreography	10%
C. Level of Confidence	10%
D. Costume	15%
E. Audience Impact	<u>5%</u>
	100%

STORY TELLING (WORDLESS PICTURE)

1. Each contestant will pick out a wordless picture book. This will be his/her piece.
2. The story shall be delivered using the mother tongue (Bikol) of the pupil- contestant.
3. Each contestant shall be given 5 minutes to deliver piece/ story.
4. The winner shall be chosen on the criteria below:

CRITERIA:

A. Story (Picture Reading)	50%
B. Voice Projection, Expression and Style	20%
C. Spontaneity	20%
D. Level of Confidence	<u>10%</u>
