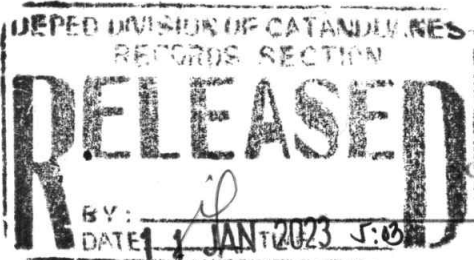

**CONDUCT OF MINI-PROVINCIAL MEET (ELEMENTARY LEVEL)**

1. Article 2 section 13 of the Philippine Constitution emphasized that the state shall promote and protect the physical, moral, spiritual, intellectual, and social well-being of the youth. One of the activities that promote the well-being of learners and teachers is the conduct of school sports program activities such as intramurals, packet tournaments, and Home- Away Meets/ Higher Meets. These activities aimed that our learners, teachers, and school administrators shall have a productive, sports activity for academic excellence and personality development of our learners and school personnel considering that sports activity remains part of the basic education program.
2. Relative to this, the SDO Catanduanes shall conduct a **mini-Provincial Meet (Elementary Level and some secondary students and coaches) on February 4-5, 2023 at Catanduanes Athletics Sports Complex** and other playing venues. The delegation of each municipality is expected to arrive on **February 3, 2023, 9:00 a.m. onwards**. In addition, all members of the Technical Working Group and Sports Event Managers and core groups are expected to report in the Division Office starting February 3, 2023. Attached is the detailed program of activities for reference.

3. In addition, district/municipal meets should be conducted on Saturday and Sunday. The try-outs, inter-school inter- district selections and trainings should be made after class hours. The participation to the Mini- Provincial Meet shall be by Municipality to observe minimum health protocol.

4. During the Mini Provincial Meet on February 4-5,2023, an opening parade shall start at 3:00 p.m. The assembly area will be at Virac Plaza Rizal. During the opening program Public Schools District Supervisors/In charge of the Districts are requested to hoist their municipal flag. Likewise, for uniformity and identification purposes, delegations from each municipality are requested to wear T-shirts with the following colors:

- Baras- Sky Blue
- Bato- Maroon
- Caramoran- Orange
- Gigmoto- Apple Green
- Panganiban- Red
- Pandan- White
- San Andres- Golden Yellow

5. Due to the absence of student-athletes, teacher-coaches, trainers, and officiating officials/from their classes on **February 3, 2023** and on **February 6, 2023** (travel time) school heads are instructed to adopt advanced or catch-up class/ school programs to compensate for the lost hours incurred as a result of their participation in the sports activity. The same instruction is given to the schools which will serve as the billeting schools. *(Please see attached billeting schools of each municipality).*

6. The pertinent documents of the athletes in connection with his/her participation in this activity should be properly checked/screened by the coaches, sports event managers and secretariat of each event before the conduct of the activity. All documents should be submitted in the SDO- SGOD c/o the DSO on **February 1, 2023**. The eligible birth date/reckoning date of athletes should be July 1,2010 or after July 1, 2010. Likewise, Head of the municipal Delegation- Public Schools District Supervisors or the Municipal Sports Coordinators are requested to submit to the DSO's email address [aroline.borja001@deped.gov.ph](mailto:aroline.borja001@deped.gov.ph) the official list of athletes, coaches, chaperons and other members of the delegation on February 1, 2023.

**MINI PROVINCIAL MEET (ELEMENTARY LEVEL)**

**GENERAL TECHNICAL GUIDELINES**

**I. INTERNATIONAL RULES AND GROUND RULES**

1. The International Rules and Regulations of the different sports events shall govern the conduct of the Mini Provincial Meet, however, international rules amended by the "Ground Rules" shall be adopted to suit local conditions. Ground Rules supersede international rules.
2. Ground rules shall agree upon by the coaches and tournament managers during the solidarity meeting. The coaches and the Sports event managers concerned must affix their signatures on the aforesaid documents and submit the same to the Division Sports Officer for approval and approval of the Schools Division Superintendent.
3. Eligible age of athletes/ reckoning dates  
Elementary- born July 1, 2010  
Secondary- born July 1, 2005

**II. OFFICIATING OFFICIALS**

DepEd personnel shall be given priority to officiate in the school sports competition, municipal meet and provincial meet, and higher meets, however, non-DepEd personnel may be tapped whenever necessary.

**III. NUMBER OF COACHES**

The Following team events whose number of athletes is above ten (10) may have 1 Assistant coach aside from the required number of coaches, hence the total coaching staff will only be two (2);

**A. Team Events:**

- Basketball (Boys and Girls)
- Football (Boys)
- Futsal (Girls- Chaperon Female Teacher)
- Sepak (Boys and Girls)
- Volleyball (Boys and Girls)
- Baseball (Elementary Boys and Girls)
- Softball (Girls)
- Baseball (Boys)

**Additional Sports to be played in the secondary:**

- Softball (Girls)
- Baseball (Boys and Girls)
- Basketball

**B. Individual Events (1 coach)**

- Archery
- Arnis
- Athletics
- Badminton
- Billiard
- Chess
- Dance sports
- Pencak
- Swimming
- Taekwondo
- Tennis
- Weightlifting

**IV. "NO COACH, NO PLAY POLICY"**

a. The policy of "NO COACH, NO PLAY Policy" shall be applied for the whole duration of the event.

b. In cases wherein, the non-appearance of the coach is justifiable, the coach concerned should immediately inform the DSO of the reason for the non-appearance during the particular game. Likewise, the Sports Event Manager should notify the DSO so that an immediate replacement of the coach shall be done to not jeopardize the play of the athletes in that particular event.

c. replacement requests may be done through writing one (1) hour before the start of the particular game.

d. The request for replacement of coach shall only be applied to those teams with one (1) coach only.

e. The team as mentioned in item no. III can no anymore ask for replacement in cases both coaches did not appear in the particular game.

**V. DEFAULTING TIME AND FORFEITURE**

a. Defaulting time is varied. It depends on the Technical Guidelines of a particular event. However, defaulting time shall not exceed 30 minutes only.

b. Defaulting time applies to the whole duration of the event.

## **VI. CODE OF CONDUCT AND PROTEST**

a. Officials and coaches who fail to observe proper conduct and decorum shall be dealt with accordingly.

b. All unsportsmanlike conduct of coaches, chaperons, trainers, athletes, and sports event managers is grounds for suspension. Furthermore, supporters of the team concerned who are unruly during the games of that particular team shall be sent out of the paying venue.

c. Protest on the technicalities arising from the games shall be solved in the following manners:

i. The tournament manager concerned is empowered to conduct an on-the-spot investigation and decide immediately on any protest so as not to disrupt the progress of the games.

ii. If the protest party is not satisfied with the decision of the sports event manager, a formal protest, signed by the coach concerned and noted by the head of the delegation may be filled with the Jury of appeals not later than 12 hours after the incident. The decision of the jury is final.

iii. When a violation of eligibility rules is proven in team compositions, the games in which the individual has taken part shall be declared forfeited in favor of the opposing team. The individual performance in case of the individual events shall be nullified.

## **VII. DECLARATION OF THE OVERALL CHAMPION**

1. The Olympic Medal Count System will be used in declaring the Overall Champion.

2. The team garnering the greatest number of gold medals shall be declared team champion. In case of a tie, the silver medal will be the basis and if there is still a tie, the bronze medal will break the tie. If the tie still exists, there will be 2 overall champions.

## **VIII. AWARDING OF MEDALS, TROPHIES, PLAQUE AND CERTIFICATES OF RECOGNITION AND PARTICIPATION**

The Sports Event Managers of the different sports may conduct awarding ceremonies at their respective venues. The 1<sup>st</sup> to 5<sup>th</sup> placers in the overall ranking will be awarded trophies during closing ceremonies.

A special performance of athletes in the different sports events shall be given due recognition through the issuance of a Certificate of Recognition. These awards shall be given during the awards ceremony of every sports event in their respective venues.

Certificate of Participation /Recognition will be given to the coaches, chaperons, trainers, officiating officials, working committees, and management.

**IX. SELECTION OF ATHLETES AND COACHES**

1. The selection of athletes in the next level of competitions shall be based on the following conditions on the award received (champion) both in individual and team events. This also applies to the coaches who will be competing in the next higher meet. In team sports, a winner- take all policy shall be adopted.

2. The DSO has the right to replace selected players who will not be able to join/play in the next higher meet for whatever reasons prevented them from joining. Likewise, upon the recommendation of the DSO, the SDS has the authority to appoint the replacement of winning coaches and team members in case of their unavailability during the higher meet.

3. In case the selected players and coaches will not be able to join in the higher meet, he/she shall write a letter stating the reasons. The letter should be signed by the parents (for the athletes) and the coach, DSO, and noted by the Schools Division Superintendent.

#### **4. Racket Games (Badminton, Table Tennis, and Tennis)**

- i. The first (1<sup>st</sup>) and second (2<sup>nd</sup>) placers in the Singles event and the first (1<sup>st</sup>) placer in doubles are automatically selected to play in the next higher meet.
- ii. Should anyone of the selected players in the singles become not available for any reason, the next in rank shall replace the player affected.
- iii. In the double players, if one of the two payers will not be able to play, the replacement shall be taken from the second-place winner in the doubles through the playoff between them.
- iv. Further replacement in the team composition (singles and doubles) shall be determined by the Sports Event Manager of the concerned event and by the DSO.

The management shall have the authority to appoint a replacement in case of the unavailability of winning coaches for the next higher meet.

#### **X. EVALUATION OF THE ACTIVITY**

The Sports Event Managers and the Secretariat of each sports event shall prepare the completion report of their respective events in coordination with the documentation and evaluation committee.

#### **XI. REPEALING CLAUSE.**

This technical guideline shall remain enforced until it is amended or rescinded.
