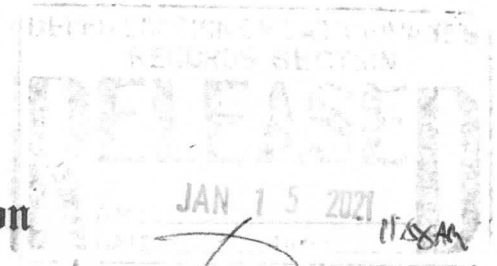

KINDERGARTEN MONITORING TOOL IN LIGHT OF THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC

To: Chief CID
Education Program Supervisors
Public Schools District Supervisors/ In Charge of the Districts
Elementary School Heads
All Others Concerned

1. Due to the threat of COVID- 19 which is evolving at present and our concern for the safety of everyone, school heads and PSDSs are encouraged to explore alternative options for conducting remote monitoring using the attached kindergarten monitoring tool to continuously monitor the quality delivery of basic education services particularly the kindergarten education program in this time of pandemic.
2. However, in such cases where follow-up visits and on-site monitoring is much needed by the concerned personnel, they are advised to strictly observe physical distancing measures, wearing of face masks and face shield and reducing frequent manipulation, have frequent and proper hand washing, and other preventive strategies in reducing the spread of COVID-19.
3. The results of the monitoring activities conducted by the school heads and PSDS shall be submitted to the concerned EPS in Kindergarten, ATTN: Dr. Gina L. Custodio as her basis in conceptualizing a relevant and appropriate interventions to close the gaps.
4. Travel expenses relative to the conduct of on-site monitoring is chargeable against MOOE fund subject to the usual accounting rules and regulations.
5. For immediate dissemination, information and compliance.
