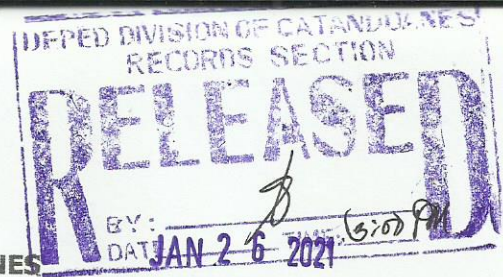

1. In consonance with LIS Announcement posted in lis.deped.gov.ph dated December 17, 2020, the Department of Education Alternative Learning System (ALS) Division of Catanduanes would like to reiterate the important advisory relative to ALS LIS encoding.

- b. Please be advised that No Longer in School (NLS) status has been renamed to **No Longer Participating in Learning Session (NLPLS)**.
- c. Facility for temporary enrolment of Grade 7 and Grade 11 learners from ALS is now available.
- d. Learners with 'Blended' Learning as Actual Modality will be required to select two (2) modalities being combined. **Note:** For learners who have selected 'Blended' as Actual Modality prior to the deployment of this enhancement are required to update.



2. **LIS for BOSY 2020-2021 is now open for encoding (Public, Private, SLUCs and ALS).** Please also be advised that the following enhancements/facilities are now available:

- a. Date of Official Enrolment (Previously Date of First Attendance)
- b. Description of Date of Official Enrolment
- c. Tagging of Country of Citizenship (located on Learner's Profile upon enrolment)
- d. Tagging of Actual Modality (located on Learner's Profile upon enrolment)

3. In this regard, this office will conduct a Division Capability Enhancement Training on the Management of Learners Information System (LIS) for all ALS Teachers.
