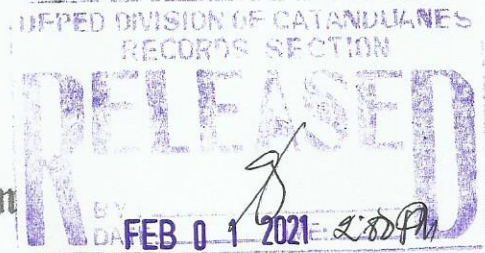

1. Criteria

- Generated Resources (40%)
- Creativity and Innovation relative to the implementation of the Learning Continuity Plan (40%)
- Alignment in the Brigada Eskwela Implementation in the light of the pandemic and calamities (20%) (Please refer to DepEd Memorandum No. 53, s. 2020 for the list of activities.)

2. Categories

- Brigada Eskwela Best Implementing Schools (one for elementary and one for secondary)
 - Brigada Eskwela Best Implementing School Heads*
 - Brigada Eskwela Best Implementing School Coordinators*
- *From the schools with the Best Implementing Schools for Brigada Eskwela in the New Normal*

3. Documents

- One-page significant accomplishments of the school along the criteria in narrative form with 2-3 photos.
 - Powerpoint presentation of accomplishment with 3-4 slides to be saved in a flash drive.
 - Personal essay both of the school heads and coordinators in times of pandemic and calamities with at least 100 words written in A4 size bond paper, double space in English. Photos of them should be saved in a flash drive.
 - The deadline of submission of documents shall be on or before **February 15, 2021**.
4. The Division Selection and Evaluation Committee for Brigada Eskwela Awards will do the document review from the schools nominated and endorsed by each district, and recommend the final nominees to the Regional Level.
5. The results of the validation done by the committee is final and irrevocable.

Interim Guidelines and Procedures in the Selection and Nomination of Stakeholders and Brigada Eskwela Awardees

Regional Brigada Eskwela Awards and Stakeholders' Appreciation
Tentative Date: April 2021

- I. Stakeholders' Appreciation
 - a) All Schools Division Offices shall determine their major stakeholders for the 2020 Brigada Eskwela implementation, namely:
 - LGUs (city/municipal/provincial) with enacted ordinances and resolutions in support to Brigada Eskwela and Learning Continuity Plan for the Gawad Brigada to LGUs;
 - top 2 Local NGAs supportive to DepEd through issuance of Memoranda and donations to schools;
 - top 2 donors from the private sector
 - Radio Stations with MOU/MOA for the implementation of the learning continuity; and
 - top 2 GPTA Officials with strong support to DepEd based on their significant contributions and active participation;
 - b) The list shall be endorsed and signed by the Schools Division Superintendents for submission to DepEd RO V- ESSD- Special Programs and Projects on or before February 15, 2021.
- II. Brigada Eskwela Awards
 - 1) All Divisions shall determine the division awardees based on the following criteria:
 - Generated Resources – 40%
 - Creativity and innovation relative to the implementation of the Learning Continuity Plan– 40%
 - Alignment in the Brigada Eskwela implementation in the light of the pandemic and calamities -20% (Please refer to DM No. 53, s. 2020 for the list of activities)
 - 2) The 2020 Regional Brigada Eskwela awardees are the following:
 - Brigada Eskwela Best Implementing Schools (two per division, one for elementary and one for secondary)
 - Brigada Eskwela Best Implementing School Heads (two per division, one for elementary and one for secondary)
(From the schools with the Best Implementing Schools for Brigada Eskwela in the New Normal)
 - Brigada Eskwela Best Implementing School Coordinators
(two per division, one for elementary and one for secondary)
(From the schools with the Best Implementing Schools for Brigada Eskwela in the New Normal)
 - 3) Brigada Eskwela Special Award
 - For the division/s with the highest generated resources
 - 4) A letter of endorsement for the Brigada Eskwela Awardees signed by the Schools Division Superintendents shall be submitted to the Regional BE Evaluation and Selection Committee together with the following documents:
 - 1) Summary of Rating for the awardee schools;
 - 2) One-page significant accomplishments of the schools along the criteria in narrative form with 2-3 photos; These accomplishments should be prepared in a power point, with 3-4 slides per school to be saved in a usb.

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3) Personal essay both of the school heads and coordinators in times of pandemic and calamities with at least 100 words written in A4 size bond paper, double space in Tagalog or English. Photos of them should be saved in a usb.

The deadline of submission for the Brigada Eskwela awardees shall be on or before February 22, 2021.

- 5) The Regional Selection and Evaluation Committee for the Brigada Eskwela Awardees will do the document review and recommend the final awardees. This will be composed of the following:






