DISSEMINATION AND UTILIZATION OF THE UPDATED CHILD PROTECTION COMMITTEE (CPC) FUNCTIONALITY ASSESSMENT TOOL

1. This is under DO No.40 s. 2012, all public and private elementary and secondary schools shall establish a Child Protection Committee (CPC) to carry out their roles and responsibilities in safeguarding the rights and protection of all learners.
2. The utilization of the Child Protection Committee Functionality Tool aims to ensure effective monitoring and evaluation of School Child Protection Committees, ensuring that they effectively fulfill their roles and responsibilities in protecting learners.
3. This further aims to strengthen the Child Protection Committee to provide concrete indicators to measure the functionality of the CPC in schools; capture the specific status of the CPCs in five areas of work; and serve as the basis and direction for the assistance from the Regional Office and SDO.
4. In this regard, all public and private schools are advised to fill out the CPC Functionality Assessment Tool at the link provided <https://tinyurl.com/CPCfunction2025> on or before January 30, 2025.
5. The Division LPRO will consolidate the list of schools that accomplished the tool, and their respective level of functionality based on the result of their self-assessment.
