- In line with the MATATAG agenda of the Department of Education, which emphasizes the holistic development of Filipino learners, the Schools Division Office of Catanduanes thru the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) shall conduct the 2025 Division Kindergarten Festival of Talents on March 28, 2025, with the theme; "Every Child is a Star: A Celebration of Talents and Potential" at the Provincial Capitol Dome, Virac, Catanduanes.
- The activity aims to:
  - 1. highlight the diverse skills, creativity, and abilities of kindergarten learners through engaging performances and activities.
  - 2. provide opportunities for children to build self-esteem, express their individuality, and share their talents with peers, parents, and the community.
  - enhance the physical, social, emotional, and cognitive development of young learners while reinforcing the core values of resilience, creativity, and joy in learning.
  - 4. strengthen the camaraderie and sportsmanship among the kindergarten learners.
- 3. All public and private schools and districts, are directed to conduct the activities on the following schedules:

- 6. It is reiterated that no disruption of classes shall occur during the elimination rounds. Teachers and school personnel involved in the contest are reminded to ensure that regular class schedules are maintained and that alternative arrangements are made to avoid any interruption to teaching and learning activities.
- 7. The general guidelines, contest mechanics for each category and the list of the Technical Working Group are attached in Enclosures 1 and 2 of this Memorandum. The planning conference of the TWG will be held on February 13, 2025, (Tuesday) at Virac Pilot Elementary School, Virac North District from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM.
- 8. The list of district winners must be submitted via link to be provided by the Curriculum Implementation Division, c/o Dr. Gina L. Custodio, on or before March 21, 2025. This ensures adequate time for the preparation of certificates of appearance and participation.
- 9. The prizes, awards, certificates and meals and snacks of the TWG and board of Judges shall be charged against the Special Education Fund (SEF) while the meals and snacks and transportation expenses of the participants shall be charged against school MOOE subject to the relevant accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 10. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is earnestly desired.



## GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR THE CONDUCT OF THE 2025 DIVISION KINDERGARTEN FESTIVAL OF TALENTS

### 1. School and District-Level Competitions

Each public school and district shall conduct its own competition to select the best contestants who will represent in the Division Level competition.

#### 2. Private Schools

Private schools shall also conduct their own competition through the Catanduanes Association of Private Schools (CAPS) to select their representatives for the Division Level competition. Private school is allotted one (1) entry per event/category.

#### 3. Eligibility

All contestants must be currently enrolled kindergarten pupils in either public or private schools within the Division of Catanduanes.

## 4. Participation

A contestant is allowed to participate in only one (1) event/category to provide opportunities for broader participation.

#### 5. Registration Fee

There shall be no registration fee for participation in the Festival of Talents at any level.

### 6. Contest Mechanics and Criteria

The specific mechanics and criteria for each contest category must be strictly followed. These are outlined in the contest guidelines below.

### Mechanics:

- Only one kindergarten contestant per district and one from private school is allowed in the contest venue.
- Contestants may be accompanied by one teacher-coach. However, they are only allowed to assist the contestant during the setting up of materials during the event.
- 3. The Drawing contest will start after the opening program at 10:00AM and end 11:30AM (2hours) and the TELL time will be in the afternoon at 1:00PM.
- 4. Contestants shall bring their own materials labeled with their names to be checked by Division TWG. The following are the materials needed.

  Mongol pencil No. 2, 1 box of crayons (16pcs per box), 1 pc 10x8 illustration board, 1 pc sharpener, 1 pc ruler (12 inches), 1pc eraser (box type), 1 long folder.
- Contestants are not allowed to bring with their photos for reference of their entries.
- The subject of the drawing shall be based on the theme which shall be given during the contest.
- The delivery during the TELL time shall be in the Mother Tongue or a language the child is comfortable with for a maximum of 5 minutes.
- The Division TWG, shall facilitate the drawing of lots and provide the necessary instructions for the smooth conduct of the contest.
