1. Relative to the National Competition scheduled March 2022, this Office through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID), shall participate in the 10TH ASEAN Quiz Regional Online Competition on March 4, 2022 (Friday at 1:00 in the afternoon using Zoom application. This shall be done using the online platform to ensure the health and safety of the participants and to comply with health standards imposed by the Department of Health and the Inter-Agency Task Force Guidelines for the Management of the Emerging Infectious Diseases.

2. The official entry/representative of this division to this online competition was based from previous competition due limited time to conduct such activity, to wit:

3. The division contestant to this competition must have the following qualifications:

- a. currently enrolled in grade 9 or 10 between 15 to 17 years old and not be 18 years by the time of Regional Competition at Myanmar in the third quarter of 2022;
- b. comes from either of the public or private schools;
- c. proficient in English both oral and written;
- d. has at least a grade of 85% in Araling Panlipunan in the First Quarter, School Year 2021-2022;
- e. physically and mentally fit;
- f. has good interpersonal skills and a good team player.

4. The Regional Winner shall be willing (with parent's consent) to travel to Quezon City for the National Competition as well as for the Regional Competition in Myanmar in 2022, if ever the student wins in the National Competition.
5. A dry run of the Quiz shall be conducted on February 23, 2022 together with the coach and Division AP Supervisors. The meeting link shall be communicated with the Supervisors a day before the dry run.
6. The division contestant/coach shall accomplish the enclosed Student Information Form and submit a scanned of the completed signed form to Ma. Leilani R. Lorico, EPS, Araling Panlipunan on February 18, 2022 in this email address: ma.lorico@deped.gov.ph.
7. Enclosed are the Guidelines and Mechanics of the online competition.

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10th ASEAN QUIZ REGIONAL COMPETITION GUIDELINES & MECHANICS
Legazpi City
March 4, 2022

GUIDELINES

1. The Regional ASEAN Quiz shall be conducted virtually using the Zoom meeting application.
2. The official contestants, their coaches (can also serve as proctors), Division Proctors, the Division Education Program Supervisors in Araling Panlipunan, and the members of the regional technical working group shall join the online platform.
3. Each contestant shall prepare two (2) gadgets. One shall be connected with the WIFI while the second gadget shall be connected with mobile data. This is to ensure the online participation of the contestants in case of internet connectivity interruptions.
4. The two (2) gadgets should have functioning cameras. One shall be placed in front of the contestant and the second gadget shall be placed at the back of the contestant. The two gadgets shall log in to the Zoom Link provided to the Division Program Supervisors in Araling Panlipunan. All cameras shall be turned on for the whole duration of the contest.
5. Contestant's display name in two (2) gadgets shall be renamed to:
Camera 1 (in front of the contestant) Display Name: Division_Camera1
Camera 2 (Back of the contestant) Display Name: Division_Camera2
6. The contestant must face a blank wall in answering and the front gadget's microphone shall be turned on for the entire duration of the event. The other gadget's microphone shall be muted.
7. Each contestant must prepare 40 sheets of clean A4 bond papers and a black-inked pentel pen. Before the start of the quiz, each contestant shall show to the screen each sheet for checking. The contestant's division name shall be written on the upper right portion of the bond paper.
8. The coach must ensure that the place where the contestant is located is free from all forms of background sounds and noise. This is to ensure that NO one is coaching the contestant while answering each item.
9. Only one division PROCTOR is allowed inside the room where the contestant is located. He/she shall take charge only of technical issues and concerns during the contest. The official coach can be the division coach at the same time.
10. The Schools Division Offices must ensure that there is a stable internet connection during the conduct of the event. WIFI connections and mobile data should be both available. A standby backup generator shall be always ready to address power supply interruption.
11. If the contestant unintentionally left the meeting due to poor internet connection or technical glitches, he/she may resume with the quiz. However, previously asked questions shall not be repeated anymore.
12. Only correct answers that are acknowledged by the Quiz Master shall be given points.
13. It is expected that all participating divisions must check all the gadgets and internet connections before the conduct of the event.

MECHANICS

1. The official contestants in the thirteen divisions should possess the qualifications stated in this Memorandum.
2. They should report to the venue 30 minutes before the start of the event and should be in their school uniforms during the contest.
3. Each contestant should be ready with 40 sheets of clean A4 bond paper and a black pentel pen during the quiz.
4. The competition has two segments.

Segment 1: True or False and Multiple Choice

Segment 2: Fill-in-the-Blanks or Completion

5. **Segment 1:** The True or False part will have 10 questions. Each correct answer will be given 1 point. The Multiple Choice part will have 10 questions. Each correct answer will be given 1 point. **The total score is 20 points.**
6. **Segment 2:** The Fill in the Blanks or Completion will have 20 questions. Each correct answer will be given 3 points. **The total score is 60 points.**
7. The total points to be obtained by the contestants in the Competition is 80.

For Segment 1 (True or False and Multiple Choice), contestants will write the word **True or False** for the True or False questions and write the **letter** of the correct answer for the Multiple Choice questions. Contestants will be given **10 seconds** to write down their answers.

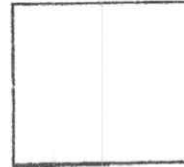
For Segment 2 (Fill-in-the-Blanks or Completion), contestants will be given **15 seconds** to write down their answers. A signal shall indicate that the time is up. Answers should be written in full; with no abbreviations or acronyms. Articles and prepositions should be correct. Answers with incorrect spelling will be considered wrong. Corrections may be made by the participants, but the previous answers must be fully erased or fully crossed out within the given time.

8. English will be used as the official language in the conduct of the quiz.
9. **Each question in Segments 1 and 2 will be read twice.** Only after the Quizmaster reads the question for the second time and says **"GO"** should the participants write their answer. When the time is up, the Quizmaster will say **"Markers Up"**. Contestants will then hold up their markers and bond paper to show their answers. The Quizmaster will read aloud the answer of each contestant. The scorers will record the answers accordingly. A cumulative score per contestant will be announced by the Quizmaster **after each round** before moving on to the next segment.
10. The test questions shall cover the three ASEAN Community Pillars (i.e. Political, Security, Economic, and Socio-Cultural), ASEAN in general, and the ASEAN Member States or AMS-specific.
11. The Test Development Sub-Committee of the 10th ASEAN National Competition will prepare and send questions to DepEd Regional Office to be used in the regional

competition. The questions will be personally delivered or handed over to DepEd Regional Office by a member of the Project Organizing Committee, who may be present to observe the conduct of the contest.

12. Suggested reference materials include, among others, official ASEAN publications from the ASEAN Secretariat in Jakarta, Indonesia and the Department of Foreign Affairs Philippines, the ASEAN websites (e.g. ASEAN Secretariat, ASEAN Communities, ASEAN Centers, etc.), website of the ASEAN Committee on Culture and Information, website of all 10 ASEAN Member States, and other relevant official websites.
13. A regional champion will be proclaimed based on the cumulative scoring system. All ties will be broken by the tiebreaker/clincher questions. Scores of contestants revert to zero during the tie-breaking portion.
14. Top three (3) winners shall be declared. However, only the first placer shall compete in the national-level competition in Quezon City in March 2022. The specific date shall be announced in a separate Memorandum.
15. In case of a protest or inquiry, only the contestant is allowed to raise it before the reading of the next question. If this will be done after the given time, the query or concern will no longer be honored. This shall be addressed orally to the organizer or the visiting member of the Project Organizing Committee and shall announce decisions resulting from the raised protest inquiry. His/her decision is final.
