- Teacher applicants who served as Volunteer Teacher/Learning Support Aide shall submit their Volunteer Acknowledgement Form or Contract of Service if LGU Funded to earn points in Experience.
- 5. The cut off score is 70% to be included in the Registry of Qualified Applicants (RQA).
- 6. The member s of the Division Selection Committee and Sub-Committee who will evaluate the documents of the applicants are entitled to CTO/COC as per CSC-DBM Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004 dated October 4, 2004 in case the activity will fall on Saturday and Sundays.
- Travel and other incidental expenses relevant to the conduct of the activities shall be charged against local/school MOOE subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
