VIRTUAL MEETING OF ALL GSP COORDINATORS

1. Anchored to Presidential Proclamation Nos. 224 s. 1998, 227 s. 1998, 759 s. 1996, 744 s. 2004 and Republic Act 6949 entitled An Act to Declare March 8 of Every Year as National Women's Day/Month. This annual celebration aims to give due recognition to the contribution of Filipino women in our society. Specifically, the 2022 celebration aims to inform and engage women as pioneers and beneficiaries of government programs and services – to promote citizen-centric governance and make “**change**” a conscious effort to know, understand, and provide what all citizens need; create and facilitate platforms to discuss good practices, gaps, challenges, and commitments in pursuing gender and development (GAD) – strengthen implementation of the Magna Carta of Women and inspire and empower women and girls to be agents of change and promote gender equality and the empowerment of all women.
2. In this connection, Proclamation No. 759, s. of 1996 - Declaring every fourth week of March as the Protection and Gender-Fair Treatment of the Girl Child Week. This underscores the need to provide every girl who is below 18 years of age with equal opportunities and adequate protection to prepare her for a role in community development. One of the activities along with this is the “**Fun Walk, Fun Talk**”.
3. To finalize the plan of activities, a virtual planning conference of all GSP coordinators will be held on **March 11, 2022 at 1:00 p.m.** The meeting link will be sent to their email before the meeting.
