Starting May, 2018 the Department of Education (DepEd), thru the Nielsen Company will be gathering baseline data in every school nationwide.

The Baseline Data Gathering Survey will focus on the DepEd Computerization Program(DCP), the DepEd Internet Connectivity Program(DICP) and the National School Building Inventory(NSBI). The data gathered will be used as comparison with the results of future monitoring and evaluation efforts to allow the Department of Education to measure the impact of the aforementioned programs.

The activity aims to establish the basic profile of each school; establish a baseline data of the DCP and DICP; and update information and current state of school buildings.

Teams will be visiting schools conducting interviews and accomplishing Baseline Data Survey forms on the following dates/schedules:
