Subject: **First Division ASEAN Academic Forum and Cultural Showcase**

DATE : July 17, 2017

1. From August 7 to 13, the Philippines, spearheaded by the Department of Education (DepEd), will celebrate the ASEAN Week. This is compliance with Proclamation no. 1008, signed in 1997, and DepEd Memo No. 143, s. 2013, enjoining government agencies to commemorate the founding date of ASEAN, the socio-economic and political organization by which the Philippines is not only a member, but also one of its founding fathers and recently assumes the ASEAN 2017 chairmanship.
2. To highlight the week-celebration, the Schools Division Office of Catanduanes will hold a 3-day Live-In First Division ASEAN Academic Forum and Cultural Showcase on August 10-12, 2017 with the theme: "Partnering for Change, Engaging the World". Participants are expected to be at the venue at Day 0, August 9, 2017 at 4:00 o'clock in the afternoon. The venue will be announced later.
3. This activity aims to strengthen awareness among teachers, school heads, supervisors, stakeholders and the community on ASEAN principles and developments and its benefits along the economic, political, social, educational and cultural progress and stability of our country.
5. The Participants are the selected elementary and secondary Araling Panlipunan and Social Science teachers, school heads and supervisors.

7. The registration fee of **two thousand four hundred pesos only (P 2,400.00)** and travel expense of each teacher/school head-participant are chargeable to school MOOE while the registration of **eight hundred pesos (800.00)** for supervisors, as well as meals and accommodations of guests, CSU auditorium rental, sound system, stage and hall decoration expenses are chargeable to HRTD subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
8. Expenses that may incurred in the preparation/performance of cultural showcase and other activities to be undertaken during the Forum and Showcase shall be chargeable to school MOOE, SEF, and other school funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
9. As per accounting rules and regulations, schools with fiscal autonomy shall pay the registration fee to the registration committee or cashier during or before the activity.
10. It is enjoined that participants shall wear an ASEAN attire during the Opening Ceremony (Day 1) at CSU Auditorium.

3. RULES FOR DEBATE COMPETITION (Team by Zone)

General Guidelines

- This debate adopts the general rule of Oxford-Oregon Debate.
- The members from each debating team must be a bona fide Araling Panlipunan/Social Science teachers of the schools of the municipality they are representing.
- The debating team must arrive 15 minutes before the start of the competition.
- Flags will be used to signal time for the debaters, as follows:
 - ✓ Green Flag will be raised to signal start time of delivery;
 - ✓ White Flag will be raised to signal only 1 minute is left;
 - ✓ Red Flag will be raised to indicate the end time of delivery.
- Judges' decision is final and irrevocable.

Team Composition

- Each debating team should be composed of 3 speakers and 1 scribe/alternate.
- Alternate speakers will only be allowed to replace a team member once during the preliminary rounds.

Preparation Time

- Proposition will be given a day before the debate competition proper. On the same time, a toss coin will be made to determine which sides each debating team will take (i.e., either the Affirmative Side or the Negative Side).

The speaking order and time allotted for the delivery of constructive speeches, Interpellation, recess, and rebuttal are as follows:
