 CONTEST GUIDELINES

DATE : April 15, 2019

1. In consonance with DepEd Memorandum No. 36, s.2019 and Regional Memorandum No.44, s.2019, this Office will conduct the 2019 Brigada Eskwela with the theme "*Matatag na Bayan para sa Maunlad na Paaralan*" on May 20-25, 2019. The Brigada Eskwela is a National Schools Maintenance Week that aims to bring together all education stakeholders to participate and contribute their time, effort, and resources to prepare public school facilities and private elementary school facilities for the opening of the school year in June. (see attached regional memorandum No. 44, s. 2019 for reference)
2. The Division Brigada Eskwela Kick-Off Program and Resilience Caravan will be held simultaneously by municipality on May 20, 2019. This activity will be spearheaded by the PSDS in each Municipality. Local Government Units (LGUs) and other education stakeholders may be tapped as partner during the Kick-Off Program and Resilience Caravan.
3. To ensure proper conduct of Brigada Eskwela Week and timely submission of Brigada Eskwela reports, you are directed to adhere on the following timeline;

24. All Regional Directors (RDs) and school's division superintendents (SDSs) shall mobilize their partnerships with school-based focal persons to ensure the effective implementation of Brigada Eskwela in all public elementary and secondary schools including the private elementary schools and the involvement of their communities.

5 School Heads (SHs) shall take the lead in planning the activities geared to making schools ecologically conscious, resilient, clean, safe, and conducive to DepEd Memorandum No.36, s.2019

6. The Brigada Eskwela Eskwela Hall of Fame Awardees shall implement innovative and community led efforts to improve student's participation and performance. The Brigada Eskwela Plus Program shall be conducted in all public schools nationwide, in phases consistent with the regular Brigada Eskwela Program. This aims to (a) achieve higher and significant goals geared towards increasing learners' participation rate, reducing dropouts and helping improve learning for both learners and community, and (b) to create a network of community based organizations to get total community commitment to attain a higher learning, through collaborative programs and projects. The implementation of Brigada Eskwela Plus Program shall focus on the following key activities.

- a. School maintenance activities throughout the school year,
- b. School and community effort to improve participation and reduce dropout rates, or to enroll in the Alternative delivery mode.
- c. School and community effort to improve student and community learning.

7. From among the Hall of Fame Awardee, each region will select one Brigada Eskwela Plus Most Sustained School Award. The details of this selection process are also contained in Enclosure No.2. (refer to DepEd Memorandum No.36, s.2019 for information)

8. The list of Municipal Evaluation Committee for the 2019 Municipal Selection for Brigada Eskwela Best Implementing School is found in Enclosure No. 3.
