**2017 METROBANK – MTAP – DEPED MATH CHALLENGE (ELIMINATION ROUND)**

**TO: Public Schools District Supervisors  
 Public & Private Elementary and Secondary School Heads**


1. The Metrobank Foundation Inc. (MBFI), the Mathematics Teachers Association of the Philippines (MTAP) and the Department of Education (DepEd) announce the holding of the 2017 Metrobank-MTAP-DepEd Math Challenge from February to April 2017 with the theme, "Moving Forward Through Excellence in Mathematics".
2. This Division will conduct the **2017 Division Metrobank-MTAP-DepEd Math Challenge (Elimination Round) for Elementary level on February 16, 2017** which will be held simultaneously by municipality at the designated Testing Centers and for **Secondary level** on February 17, 2017 at the Catanduanes National High School.
3. The over-all objective of the competition is to contribute in improving the quality of mathematics education in the Philippines. Specifically it aims to:
  - a. awaken greater interest in mathematics among elementary pupils and secondary students in both public and private schools;
  - b. encourage pupils/students to strive for excellence in Mathematics;
  - c. encourage them to master the basic mathematical skills;
  - d. discover mathematical talents among the pupils and students.
  - e. develop the values of hard work, perseverance, honesty, teamwork and sportsmanship;
  - f. provide them with opportunities in leadership and cooperative undertaking.
4. The elimination round for elementary will be conducted on the following venues:

5. Each principal/head teachership school will send three (3) contestants per grade level both in elementary & secondary schools.
6. The Division Special Science and Mathematics Class (DPSSMC), JMAMES SPED Center, CSC Laboratory School, Ville St. John School, Dr. Guillermo Reyes Adventist School, STAR Learners School and SILOAH are allotted three (3) contestants each per grade level.



7. The participants are expected to report to their respective venue before 7:30 a.m. of the scheduled date.
8. The host principal is requested to conduct a short opening program, do preparation of the contest venue/hall and registration sheets by grade level.
9. The PSDSs & Secondary School Head who are assigned as Testing Center Coordinators are required to claim the testing materials from the Division Math Supervisor a day before the test. However, the test materials shall be opened publicly by the Testing Center Coordinator just before the start of the competition.
10. The list of Testing Center Coordinators, Room Supervisors, number of examination rooms and elementary Proctors (to be assigned by concerned PSDS), designated Secondary Proctors and secretariat, mechanics for the elimination round, the guidelines for proctors and report templates are enclosed for the guidance of all concerned.
11. The assigned proctors are tasked to manage the checking of the answer sheets right after the test using the answer keys provided. Answer Keys shall be opened just before the correction begins.
12. The Testing Center Coordinators are required to submit on the same day the following Consolidated Report by grade level :
  - a. Individual Results of contestant
  - b. Ranked School's score obtained from the average of the top two scorers
  - c. Ranked School's score obtained from the average scores of the three contestants
  - d. Final List of Contestant and coaches by School
  - e. Checked answer sheets
13. All public and private schools are required to accomplish a one page registration form (MMC Form 1) which shall be submitted on the scheduled elimination round to the Coordinator of the testing center for compilation and turn-over to the EPS In-Charge of Mathematics.
14. The Public Schools District Supervisors, Elementary and Secondary School Heads and mathematics teachers are requested to actively campaign and enjoin support to the competition of all public and private schools in this division.
15. The travel expenses in the participation to this activity are chargeable to the school MOOE subject to the usual auditing and accounting rules and regulations.
16. Immediate and wide dissemination of this memorandum is desired.
