## 3<sup>rd</sup> Division Alternative Learning System (ALS) Encampment for Out-of-School Youths and Adults

- 1. The Schools Division Office of Catanduanes Alternative Learning System (ALS) through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) will hold the 3<sup>rd</sup> Division Alternative Learning System (ALS) Encampment for Out-of-School Youths and Adults on May 19, 2023 at Virac Central Elementary School, Gogon Sirangan, Virac, Catanduanes with the theme: "ALS 2.0: Kaagapay sa Paglinang ng Tibay at Husay ng mga Pilipino".
- 2. This Division encampment aims to:
  - equip the out-of-school youths (OSYs) and adults with life-long skills considered significant in helping them become effective, efficient and responsive citizens;
  - b. strengthen their spiritual and moral values, and
  - c. develop self-reliant, dynamic and creative leaders to become who are catalysts of change.
- 3. Participants to this activity are Out-of-School Youths and Adults currently enrolled in any ALS program (A&E Elementary, Junior High School, ALS SHS of nine (9) implementing schools) who are winners in the District Level/ School Level (for ALS SHS).
- 4. Aside from the ALS learners, Public Schools District Supervisors, ALS Teachers, selected Community ALS Implementors (winning coach) are also expected to be present during the encampment. Interested stakeholders are likewise encouraged to participate, provided that their attendance is endorsed by their respective heads of the organization.
- 5. All participants are required to comply with all guidelines for COVID-19 Alert Level System set by the national and local Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases (IATF), as well as the most recent DepEd rules and/or policies.
- 6. There shall be no registration fee. Travel and other incidental expenses of participants shall be charged to LGU/SEF/GAD/Local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 7. Program of Activities, Working Committees, Contest Event Participants Form, contest rules and guidelines are found in the attached enclosures.



- 8. Winners of the academic contest and identified players per zone for sports will represent the Division to the Regional OSY Encampment on June 5-9, 2023 at Pili Sports Complex, San Jose Pili, Camarines Sur. Coaches shall exert time and efforts to review/practice the contestants to prepare them to these activities.
- 9. Division Planning Conference relative to this activity will be conducted on April 28, 2023 1:00 o'clock in the afternoon at SDO Lobby to be attended by the CID Chief, Division ALS Focal Person, Education Program Specialists for ALS, Public Schools District Supervisors/ District In-Charge and one (1) ALS teacher per district.
- 10. Immediate and wide dissemination of this memorandum to all concerned is earnestly desired.

#### GENERAL GUIDELINES

- 1. Only registered learner-participants with medical certificate, parent/guardian's consent and waiver can join in the athletics events, and ballgames.
- 2. Only registered participants are allowed to stay in the venue.
- 3. Wearing of ID is a must for identification and security purposes. Without ID, one cannot participate in any event.
- 4. All participants must have a vaccination card.
- 5. The contest is open to all registered participants to the 3<sup>rd</sup> Division Alternative Learning System (ALS) Encampment for Out-of-School Youth and Adult (OSY/OSA) whose names appeared in the Learners Information System (LIS).
- 6. A participant is allowed to compete in one individual academic contest only.
- 7. There shall be a contest briefing 15 minutes before contest administration, thus, clarifications could be made.
- 8. Contestant numbers shall be determined through drawing of lots.
- 9. The top five winners will be declared as 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th Placers.
- 10. In case of tie, the facilitator/chairman should break it.
- 11. Anyone caught in any act of cheating, or any form of dishonesty shall automatically be disqualified.
- 12. The decision of the Board of Judges is final.

#### SPECIFIC GUIDELINES

#### I. ESSAY WRITING CONTEST (Individual Event)

- 1. One (1) contestant per district shall be eligible to join the contest.
- 2. The essay should revolve around the theme which will be announced during the contest proper.
- 3. The essay must be written in Filipino, on a yellow paper provided by the division/contestant with 1-inch margin on all sides.
- 4. The essay shall be cursive, or sentence e case written legibly in either black or blue pen only. The use of pencil is not allowed.
- 5. Contestant will be given one hour to complete their essay. They shall not be allowed to leave the contest place once the contest has officially started. Minimum of 300 words and maximum of 500 words is required.
- 6. Each entry shall be identified by a number which will be drawn that correspond to the number and identity of the contestants.
- 7. Criteria for judging:

Content/Relevance to the theme - 40%
Unity/organization of idea - 40%
Grammar/Semantics - 20%
TOTAL 100%

#### II. ALS QUIZ (Team Event)

- 1. Contestant must be ALS Learner of the district they are representing.
- 2. The contest shall be a team competition composed of 3 members with one coach only.
- 3. English shall be used as the official language in the conduct of the quiz.
- 4. Question shall focus on basic environment fact, concepts, laws, current events, initiatives and other subject pertaining to environment, climate change, disaster risk reduction, numeracy and Life Skills Modules.
- 5. Each contestant will prepare 1 Easy question (True or False); 1 Average question (multiple choice, 3 choices); and 1 Difficult question (simple recall no option) The quiz master shall draw 10 questions for each category from all the submitted questions as the official questions for the Quiz.
- 6. Point system for every correct answer: Easy one (1) point, Average two (2) points, Difficult three (3) points.
- 7. Each question shall be read twice by the Quiz Master. The contestants shall only answer as soon as the Quiz Master read the question and signals the time to write the answer called for. Countdown starts immediately thereafter.
- 8. Contestants shall be given a period of 5 seconds for Easy questions, 10 seconds for Average questions and 15 seconds for the Difficult ones.
- 9. The contestants shall bring a drill board and shall write their answers on it. The contestants shall be allowed to change answer only within the time allotted for a particular question.
- 10. The contestants shall raise their drill boards as soon as the allotted time to answer is over.
- 11. In case of a tie, a tie breaker question shall be asked until a winner is declared.
- 12. The top three contestants who accumulate the most points after 45 questions shall be declared the First, Second and Third placers respectively and will represent our division as a team during the Regional Encampment.

#### III. SPELLING CONTEST (Individual Event)

- 1. One (1) contestant per district shall participate in the contest.
- 2. EACH district will provide 5 words to be spelled. Each word is written in a ¼ crosswise A4 bond paper, which will be given during the contest proper. Each word must have meaning and must be used in a sentence.
- 3. Twenty-five (25) English words with minimum of 3 syllables per word shall be used.
- 4. Each word shall be read twice by the Quizmaster. The contestants shall only answer as soon as Quiz-Master signals that it is time to write the word.
- 5. Contestants shall be given a maximum of 10 seconds to write the word. Should the contestant decide to change the answer, he/she shall erase or cross the answer with only one horizontal line and the new answer shall be written legibly above the crossed-out answer. The contestant shall be allowed to change answer only within the time allotted for a particular question.
- 6. The contestants shall raise their pentel pens/chalks as soon as the allotted time to spell the word is over.
- The facilitators will then collect the drill board, check the spelling/answer of the contestant and record the point/s of those who got the correct spelling of the word.
- 8. The top three contestants who accumulate the most points for all the three (3) categories shall be declared the First, Second and Third placers respectively.

#### IV. Slogan Making Contest (Individual Event)

- 1. One (1) contestant per district shall participate in the contest.
- 2. The slogan must have a minimum of five (5) and a maximum of ten (10) words.
- 1. Filipino is the medium to be used. It must be written in  $\frac{1}{4}$  sized white cartolina.
- 2. The Slogan should revolve around the theme which will be announced by the contest administrator during the contest proper.
- 3. The allotted time to prepare the slogan is 30 minutes. All entries shall be submitted to the contest chairman. Contestant may decide to submit his/her slogan earlier than the allotted time.
- 4. A contestant should read and explain the slogan in 5 minutes after all contestants completed the allotted time of 30 minutes.
- 5. Each slogan shall be identified by number that correspond to the number and identity of the judging process.
- 6. Judging shall be based on the following criteria:

Content - 30%
Relevance to the theme
Delivery - 40%
Total 100%

#### V. On the Spot-Poster-Making Contest (Individual Event)

- 1. One (1) contestant per district shall participate in the contest.
- 2. The poster should revolve around the theme which will be announced by the contest administrator during the contest proper.
- 3. The medium for visual artistry shall be 3 primary colors plus black and white cray pas oil pastel to be drawn in ¼ sized white illustration board for Elementary level and ½ sized illustration board for Junior High School level.
- 4. The allotted time for the contest is two (2) hours. All entries shall be submitted to the contest chairman. Contestant may decide to submit his/her poster on or before the allotted time of 2 hour.
- 5. Poster must carry caption and or message in English, Filipino or Bicol.
- 6. Permanent marker/Pentel pen will be allowed for caption only.
- 7. Each poster shall be identified only by a number that corresponds to the number and identity of the contestant for judging process.
- 8. Judging shall be based on the following criteria:

Originality of idea - 40%
Relevance to the theme
Visual Impact - 20%
Total 100%

#### VI. ANAGRAM ENGLISH (Individual Event)

1. To be participated by one (1) representative per district.

2. Participant of the district must have been officially registered in the official entry form.

3. Each contestant shall form as many words as they can from the given word o be written in a yellow pad paper. The pad paper and ballpen shall be brought by

the contestant. One syllable word shall be given one (1) point, two syllable words shall be given two (2) points and three or more syllable word shall be given three (3) points.

- 4. The time allotment will be given depending on the difficulty of the word.
- 5. Words to be formed must be correct spelling and with meaning.

3(three) letter word - 1 point 4 (four) letter word - 2 points 5 (five) letter word - 3 points 6 (six) up letter word - 4 points

- 6. The 5 words to be used in the contest will be given by the ALS Division Office.
- 7. Winner will be determined as to the number of points earned per word.

#### VII. MR. & MS. ALS BICOLANDIA (Learners' Category)

- 1. Each zone must have one (1) pair of learner-contestant for the pageant.
- 2. The contestants will compete in production number, casual wear, and question and answer (through picture analysis). Costume shall be provided by zone.
- 3. Each zone shall submit 1 hard and soft copy of the picture that will be used in the Q&A one hour before the pageant begins.
- 4. Coach and make-up artist must be a learner or Community ALS Implementer or ALS Teacher.
- 5. Judging shall be based on the following criteria:

- 2. Each division shall have 1 entry for TV infomercial.

- 3. Maximum running time of the said infomercial is 60 seconds only and must not be lower than 45 seconds.
- 4. The infomercial is focused on the theme.
- 5. Using of Filipino and/or English as medium of language is allowed.
- 6. Any forms of multi-media devices are allowed in creating TV infomercial. Any for m of video-camera is permitted.
- 7. All concepts must be original and no part of it was obtained from any radio/TV shows or radio/TV commercials. All pictures and videos must be original. It must be in MP4 format.
- 8. Voice-over of the contestant or of another person is allowed. Contestant himself /herself or other person can be the lead or main actor/actress in the infomercia l.
- Entries shall be submitted on or before the day of Academic contest, until 9:00
  am of May \_\_\_, 2023 Submitted after said schedule shall not be considered as en
  try.
- 10. Entry must have complete file name and schools' division in the softcopy. The s ubmitted MP4 is likewise labelled outside with the word Infomercial, name of contestant and division.
- 11. Non-compliance of at least 1 of the items in guidelines 1 to 10 shall mean di squalification for the final judging.
- 12. The criteria for judging are as follows:

a. Story & Relevance to the Theme	35%
b. Originality	20%
c. Technicality (Video color and Clarity of Sound, etc.)	30%
d. Consumer Impact & Values Infusion	15%
TOTAL	100%

13. The decision of the Panel of Judges is final and not appealable.

#### VIII. SPOKEN POETRY (ALS SHS Learner's Category)

- 1. Each division shall have one representative only.
- The piece shall be originally composed. Spoken Poetry shall be in Filipino dialect.
- 3. The contestant is given 3-5 minutes to deliver his/her piece.
- 4. The contestant shall be in casual attire.
- 5. The following are the criteria for judging:

Content	40%
Delivery	40%
Stage Presence	10%
Audience Impact	10%
TOTAL-	100 %

#### IX. CREATIVE WRITING (ALS SHS Learner's Category)

- 1. One ALS SHS contestant per division shall be eligible to join the contest.
- The topic/theme will depend on the learner's interpretation of the picture which will be given by the Regional Office and shall be revealed during the contest pr oper.

- 3. It must be written in English, on a yellow pad paper provided by the organizers with one-inch margin on all sides.
- 4. It shall be written legibly in black or blue ink only. Pencil is not allowed.
- Contestants will be given one hour to complete their creative writing. They shall
  not be allowed to leave the contest venue once the contest has officially started.
  A minimum of 300 words and maximum of 500 words is required.
- 6. Each entry shall be identified by a number which will be drawn that correspond to the number and identity of the contestants.
- 7. Criteria for judging shall be based on the following:

Grammar/Semantics	- 20%
