

REGISTRATION OF THE QUALIFIED STUDENT VOTERS TO THE 2022 NATIONAL AND LOCAL ELECTIONS

Assistant Schools Division Superintendent Chief, Curriculum Implementation Division Chief, Schools Governance and Operations Division Public Schools District Supervisor Secondary School Heads

Relative to OUA MEMO 00-0421-0105 pursuant to Republic Act (RA) No. 8189, otherwise known as the Voter's Registration Act of 1996, the Office of the Undersecretary for Administration (OUA) through the Bureau of Learner Support Services — Youth Formation Division (BLSS-YFD) encourages all eligible learners and young people to exercise their rights and actively participate in the National and Local Elections on May 09, 2022.

All eligible learners are encouraged to register at the nearest Commission on Elections (COMELEC) office while strictly observing the existing Inter-Agency Task Force (IATF) guidelines in their respective communities.

Section 9 of RA No. 8189 and Section 5 of COMELEC Resolution No. 10549 expressly provide the following qualifications/requirements for voter's registration:

- Any Filipino citizen who is not yet a registered voter, may apply for registration, provided he/she is at least eighteen (18) years of age on or before May 9, 2022 National and Local Elections; immediately preceding the May 9, 2022 National and Local
- A resident of the Philippines for at least one (1) year and in the place wherein he/she proposes to vote, for at least six (6) months Elections; and

- · Not otherwise disqualified by law.
- Any person who has not reached the required voting age or period
 of residence on the day of registration but will possess such
 qualifications on or before the May 9, 2022 National and Local
 Elections, may register as a voter. However, the reception of their
 applications shall commence only on May 10, 2021 (at least one
 year prior to election day).

In this connection, the OUA through the Schools Division Office would like to request all Supreme Student Government (SSG) presidents and teacher-advisers to come up with a voter's registration campaign that will inspire qualified learners to register and participate in the elections.

REGISTRATION OF QUALIFIED STUDENT VOTERS TO THE

2022 NATIONAL AND LOCAL ELECTIONS

Pursuant to Republic Act (RA) No. 8189, otherwise known as the *Voter's Registration Act of 1996*, the Office of the Undersecretary for Administration (OUA) through the Bureau of Learner Support Services – Youth Formation Division (BLSS-YFD) encourages all eligible learners and young people to exercise their rights and actively participate in the National and Local Elections on May 09, 2022.

In consideration of the importance of voting in a democratic society, all eligible learners are encouraged to register at the nearest Commission on Elections (COMELEC) office while strictly observing the existing Inter-Agency Task Force (IATF) guidelines in their respective communities.

Section 9 of RA No. 8189 and Section 5 of COMELEC Resolution No. 10549 expressly provide the following qualifications/requirements for voter's registration:

- Any Filipino citizen who is not yet a registered voter, may apply for registration, provided he/she is at least eighteen (18) years of age on or before May 9, 2022 National and Local Elections;
- A resident of the Philippines for at least one (1) year and in the place wherein he/she proposes to vote, for at least six (6) months immediately preceding the May 9, 2022 National and Local Elections; and
- Not otherwise disqualified by law.
