ADMINISTRATION OF ECCD POST ASSESSMENT FOR KINDERGARTEN PUPILS

TO: SDO Chiefs

Education Program Supervisors Public Schools District Supervisors Elementary Heads of Public and Private Schools Kindergarten Teachers

- 1. Pursuant to DepEd Order No. 47, s. 2016 entilted "Omnibus Policy for Kindergarten Education Program (KEP)", assessment for kindergarten will be conducted twice a year, at the beginning and at the end of school year. The assessment will use the Philippine Early Childhood Development Checklist (ECCD). This is the standard tool in assessing the developmental domains of five-year old children. The importance of administering this assessment is for the teachers to establish individual profiles of their learners, guide the teachers to modify objectives and learning experiences to meet individual needs of children. It also helps teachers determine whether learners may need further assessment or special intervention.
- 2. The post assessment will be administered by the kindergarten teachers with the support of the Public Schools District Supervisors and their respective school heads on March 6-10, 2017.
- 3. It is expected that the administration of the ECCD post assessment will follow the standard procedures given during the 3-day training-workshop previously conducted to all kindergarten teachers at Amenia Beach Resort.
- 4. The district consolidated results of the ECCD post assessment will be submitted at the SDO-CID on March 15, 2017 Attn: Ms. Gina L. Custodio, EPS, In-Charge of Kindergarten for data analysis, thus, proper interventions and technical assistance could be extended to the concerned individuals and persons in the field.
- 5. Further, School Progress Report Card for Quarter 3 & 4 should likewise be submitted on March 15, 2017.
