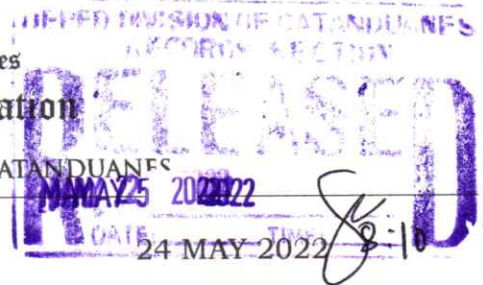

**REGIONAL PILOT UTILIZATION OF MONITORING AND EVALUATION TOOLS IN
BLENDED LEARNING**

To: Schools Division Superintendents

1. For the past months, this Office, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division and in partnership with ABC+: Advancing Basic Education in the Philippines, has actively engaged the Schools Division Offices in a series of workshops that are intended to develop monitoring and evaluation tools in blended learning.
2. Seven standards for blended learning have been identified: Content Development, Assessment, Learning Resources, Home Learning Support, Monitoring and Evaluation, Social-Emotional Learning, and Learning and Development; and these are seen as critical components to maintain quality in the delivery and practice of blended learning in the elementary and secondary schools in Region V.
3. The following monitoring tools have been crafted, with designated monitors and target respondents:

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4. Pilot utilization of the eight M & E Tools in the 13 Schools Divisions will be managed by the Curriculum Implementation Division, in partnership with the senior education program specialist for monitoring, management and evaluation, and should be conducted not later than June 10, 2022. This is the suggested timeline:

- May 23-27 2022- Division orientation to concerned monitors
- May 30-June 3, 2022- Pilot utilization of the eight M & E Tools
- June 6-10, 2022- Encoding the data in Excel, analysis of the data, creating the norms (for the assigned Standard and M&E tool)
- June 13-17, 2022- Presentation of the analyzed data in tables (for the assigned Standard and M&E tool) during the Regional Workshop

5. Prior to the pilot utilization, the following should be determined:

- a. Identify who will be monitored and how many
 - Teachers= 100
 - School heads= 30
 - Schools= 30
- b. Equitable distribution of respondents (elementary/secondary, grade level, learning area if teachers)
- c. Platform: online or paper & pen

6. Copies of the M & E tools have been made accessible to the M & E SEPS of the divisions and should be distributed to the monitors during the Orientation. Online M & E tools can be accessed in this Google Drive:

7. Online respondents to the M & E tools should access the indicated URL in the table of item #3 of this Memorandum.

8. Division monitors are highly encouraged to conduct discussions and interviews to selected respondents in order to generate feedback on the utilization of the M and E tools. Consolidated feedback, comments and suggestions of the respondents will be part of the discussions during the regional workshop on June 13-17, 2022.
