 - 3. Interview with the School Coordinator as she/he answers the attached School Questionnaire
 - b. School-Based Feeding Program Forms and Program Terminal Report
- 3. The Schools Division Superintendent will create a Schools Division Search Committee who will evaluate the submitted entries and will choose among them the Top 5 (five) Best Implementing Schools. First place in the division level contest will be the Official Entry of the SDO Catanduanes for the Regional Search for the Best SBFP MF Implementers for SY 2020-2021.
