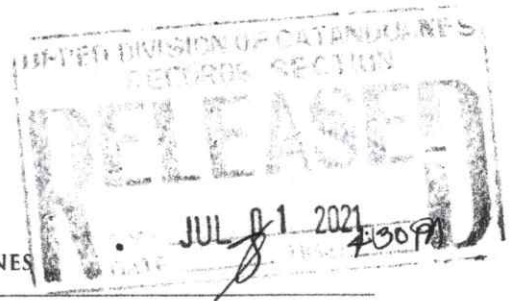

**ACTUAL NUMBER OF SCHOOL DAYS (TEACHING AND LEARNING ACTIVITIES) FOR  
SCHOOL YEAR 2020-2021**

1. Consistent with the amendments of some department orders relative to the implementation of School Calendar and Activities for School Year 2020-2021 like DepEd Order Nos. 7 & 30 s. 2020 and 12, s. 2020 due to the unprecedented outbreak of COVID – 19, similarly our province experienced severe weather disturbances which brought devastating effect in the lives of many constituents which have resulted to suspensions of the modular distance learning activities.
2. Even with the numerous suspensions of teaching and learning activities brought by calamities it is still necessary to adhere to the Republic Act No. 11480 (*An Act Amending Section 3 of RA No. 7797, Otherwise Known As "An Act Lengthen the School Calendar from Two Hundred (200) days to not More Than Two Hundred Twenty (220) Days*). Hence, the number of class days for school year 2020-2021 should reconcile with this provision.
3. As specified under DepEd Order Nos. 7 & 30 s. 2020 holding of Saturdays as learning activities are authorized and it is counted in the Number of Class Days because of the Compressed school year. Likewise, inasmuch as Sundays are being utilized by learners, teachers and school heads as part of the distance learning activities and monitoring as well, it is therefore justifiable that **Sundays in the months of October 2020 to July 2021**, should be included in the Number of Teaching and Learning Activities since **these days as make up class through conduct of distance learning activities**.



4. For uniformity as to the exact number of teaching and learning activities, enclosed is the Actual Number of Class Days per month based from the adjusted School Calendar and Activities for School Year 2020-2021.
5. Immediate and wide dissemination of this memorandum is earnestly desired.
