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

4. The ASEAN Quiz Competition shall be participated in by selected high school students based from the following criteria:
 - a. be in Grades 9-10 between fifteen (15) to seventeen (17) years old; must not be 18 years old by the time of the Regional Competition which will be held in the first quarter of 2020;
 - b. come from either a public or private school;
 - c. be proficient in the English language, both oral and written;
 - d. have a grade of 85 and above in Social Studies in the first quarter of School Year 2019-2020;
 - e. have good interpersonal skills/ be a good team player;
 - f. be physically fit;
 - g. be willing (with parental consent) to travel for the Regional/National Competition
 - h. meet other criteria that may be deemed necessary by the ASEAN Quiz Organizing Committee Philippines.
5. The Bicol Patiribayan in Araling Panlipunan and SPED is open to elementary, Junior and Senior High School students including ALS. It is expected that a District/Municipal Elimination Contest shall be conducted to select the division contestant and List of contestants per municipality per events shall be submitted to this office on September 27, 2018. The Catanduanes National High School (CNHS) shall be excluded in the municipal elimination, thus the school will be counted as one unit, likewise, the private schools will be counted as one unit also.
6. The First Place winners shall represent the division in the 9TH Bicol Patiribayan Festival in Araling Panlipunan, SPED and ASEAN Quiz Competition respectively.
7. Enclosed are the working committees, allotment of official participants and the specific guidelines for each skill exhibition both in Patiribayan and ASEAN Quiz Competition..
8. In preparation for the conduct of the activity, an Orientation Conference of the Working Committees shall be held on September 27, 2019 at 1:00 in the afternoon at the SDO-CID Office.

THE 9TH ASEAN QUIZ DIVISION COMPETITION

9th Quiz Mechanics for the Competition Proper

October 1-2, 2019

1. The student-participants from 11 municipalities shall compete individually in two segments
2. The two (2) segments are as follows:
Segment 1: True or False and Multiple Choice
Segment 2: Fill-in-the-Blanks or Completion
3. **Segment 1:** The True or False part will have 10 questions. Each correct answer will be given 1 point. The Multiple Choice part will have 10 questions. Each correct answer will be given 1 point. **Total score is 20 points.**
4. **Segment 2:** The Fill in the Blanks or Completion will have 20 questions. Each correct answer will be given 3 points. **Total score is 60 points.**
5. The total points for the Competition is 80.
6. The participants shall be seated in individual chairs with armrest.
7. Each participant shall bring $\frac{1}{4}$ size white cardboard, a marker and an eraser to be used in answering the questions for Segments 1 and 2. Participants will write their answers on the white cardboard.
8. For **Segment 1 (True or False and Multiple Choice)**, participants will write the word True or False for the **True** or **False** questions and write the letter of the correct answer for the Multiple Choice questions. Participants will be given **10 seconds** to write down their answer.
9. For **Segment 2 (Fill in the Blanks or Completion)**, participants will be given 15 seconds to write down their answers. A buzzer shall indicate that the time is up. Answers should be written in full, with no abbreviations or acronyms. Articles and prepositions should be correct. Answers with wrong spelling will be considered wrong. Corrections may be made by the participants but the previous answers must be fully erased or fully crossed out within the given time allotment.
Each question in Segments 1 and 2 will be read twice. After the Quizmaster reads the question the second time, he/she will say 'GO'. Only then will the participants write their answer. When the time is up, the Quizmaster will say "Markers Up". Participants will then hold up their markers and whiteboards to show their answers. The Quizmaster will read aloud the answers of each participant. The scorers will record the answers accordingly. A cumulative score per participant will be announced by the Quizmaster **after each round** before moving on to the next segment.
10. The Organizing Committee and Sub-Committee on Test Development and Quiz Mechanics shall provide technical support and clarification deemed necessary by the Board of Judges.
11. **Scoring Systems.** There will be two scoring systems to ensure correctness of tabulations: (1) by computer, and (2) manually, using scoring sheets and a tabulation board prominently displayed for the reference of the student-participants, the Board of Judges, the Competition Organizing Committee, the Sub-Committee on Test Development and Quiz Mechanics, coaches and other guests.
12. After the completion of Segment 2, the cumulative points earned by each participant in the two segments will be tabulated. The results will be examined and verified by the Ninth ASEAN Quiz Organizing Committee. When the results have been verified, these will be submitted to the Board of Judges and announced accordingly by the Quizmaster.
13. The Chairman of the Board of Judges shall declare the First, Second and Third Place Winners. The highest pointer, the first place winner shall represent the Division in the Ninth ASEAN Quiz Regional Competition in October 2019. The second place winner shall be declared as the alternate team member in case anyone of the first place winners will be unable to go to the 9th Regional Competition.
14. In case of a tie, tiebreaker question/s shall be asked until definite winner/s emerge. At the start of the tiebreaker round, the scores revert to zero.
15. Should there be questions or protests, the Board of Judges shall decide on the matter. Their decision is final.

a. Event Rules and Mechanics

Round-Table Argumentation and Debate

The event is a combination of argumentation and debate that is conducted in a round table discussion. It enables the contestant to use his critical analysis and deep reasoning about the different issues that occur in the society. This also develops the ability of the students to organize his ideals promptly and logically.

The event shall follow the rules and guidelines below:

- a. There shall only be one (1) contestant/debater from each division. The debater shall be accompanied and trained by the duly approved coach.
- b. Each contestant shall wear corporate attire. Moreover, they are required to present their valid school ID during the registration.
- c. Contestants shall be assigned a number that will correspond to the number on the judging sheet.
- d. Topics to be debated shall revolve on the following issues: country's foreign and economic policies, environment, gender and society, governance, peace and order, population and reproductive health, and other current/contemporary issues.
- e. The debater is required to use the English language as a medium except for terminologies on certain topics that are only stated in Filipino.
- f. The debate will consist of two rounds:

Round I: Elimination Round

- A. Each debater will be given a maximum of 3 minutes to deliver his/her speech on the topic drawn.

- B. After the discourse of the first contestant/debater, the second debater will interpolate on the speech of the first debater. The questions for the interpolation will be focused on the arguments of the opponent. Categorical questions will be allowed (Answerable by yes or no), however, the responder may choose to qualify or not his/her answer. A total of five (5) minutes shall be allotted to other contestants to ask their clarifications, rebuttal and other questions.
- C. The second contestant will also give his/her speech on the topic, the third debater will be asking questions to debater 2, debater 3 will be asked by debater 4, debater 4 by debater 5, debater 5 by debater 6 and so on.

Round 2 : Final Round

- D. After the first round, eight (8) debaters will be chosen to proceed to the second round.
- E. The debaters will be following the same order as the first round.
- F. A new topic for debate will be given on the second round. The topics will also be selected from the issues enumerated previously during the first round.
- G. The same process from round 1 (letter c) shall be followed.
- H. Prompting and coaching during the duration of the debate shall be strictly prohibited.

g. The criteria for judging are:

Delivery -	20%
(tone of voice, use of gestures, and level of enthusiasm are convincing to others)	
Use of supporting evidence -	25 %
(examples and facts to support reasons with references)	
Organization -	25 %
(view points and responses are outlined both clearly and orderly)	
Reasoning and ability to answer -	30 %
(reasons are given to support viewpoints, arguments made by the other are responded to and dealt with effectively)

I. Event Rules and Mechanics

- a. The quiz is open to all types of learners who are officially enrolled in grades 4-6
- b. The team shall be composed of one (1) regular learner and one (1) learner with special needs such as those with seeing and hearing impairment, physically challenged, learners with autism who are highly functional and manageable in the mainstream program (to present valid MOVs that will justify the learner).
- c. Test questions shall be based on Araling Panlipunan Grades 4-6 competencies. References are textbooks/materials released by Bureau of Learning Resources (BLR) of DepEd and Philippine History Books.
- d. During the quiz, participants shall be provided with white board, markers and erasers.
- e. Filipino shall be used as the official language in the conduct of the quiz.
- f. Participants shall be given a total number of twenty (20) questions, of which six (6) are "easy," seven (7) are "average," and seven (7) are "difficult."
- g. Points for every correct answer shall be given as follows: One (1) point for "easy" question (multiple choice), Two (2) points for "average" question (multiple choice), and Three (3) points for "difficult" question (identification). In case of tie, a clincher question drawn from the "difficult" category shall be asked until a winner emerges.
- h. Participants shall be given ten (10) seconds for easy, twelve (12) seconds for average, and fifteen (15) seconds for difficult round to answer the question.
- i. The quizmaster shall read each question twice. Countdown shall start after the question has been read the second time and the quizmaster says "GO". When the quizmaster says "STOP" or "TIME IS UP", contestants must raise their answers to the audience and to the Board of Judges until such time that the proctors have verified or confirmed the answer. Those who are unable to observe the instruction shall not earn a point.
- k. The participants are allowed to change their answer within the allotted time.
- l. Regional winners shall be proclaimed based on cumulative scoring.

m. In case of a protest or inquiry during the actual quiz proceedings, the following procedures shall be observed:

- Only the contestants or the official coaches are allowed to raise a protest or inquiry before the next question is read.
- The protest or inquiry shall be addressed orally to the chair of the board of judges who shall recognize the protest or inquiry after validating the proof / evidence presented.
- The chair shall announce the decision upon deliberation with the members of the board of judges.

n. The decision of the Board of Judges is final.
