The declaration of **November as the Filipino Values Month** was through Proclamation No. 479 dated October 25, 1994 in consonance with the Moral Recovery Program (Proclamation 62 dated September 30, 1992). The objectives are to strengthen the Filipino culture, values and ideals that are pro-God, pro-people, pro-country and pro-nature, and mobilize all Filipinos for nation-building through the practical exercise of human values in daily lives as citizens and to awaken us all to the power of these values in achieving individual and national goals (Proclamation 479, Paragraph 1).
2. In consonance with this mandate, DepEd Memorandum No. 166, s. 2018 (National Observance of the Filipino Values Month) and Unnumbered Regional Memorandum dated October 22, 2018, this division encourages all public and private schools to hold meaningful activities for learners, teaching and non-teaching personnel, parents and other stakeholders which include but not limited to the following:
 - a. opening/culminating activities
 - b. display of tarpaulins
 - c. symposia
 - d. seminar
 - e. recollections
 - f. movie making/ review
 - g. slogan making
 - h. poster making
 - i. jingle making
 - j. spoken poetry
 - k. life story composition
 - l. tagis talino
 - m. other parallel activities

It is reiterated that in the conduct of such activities, the policy on time-on-task must be strictly adhered to.

3. This year's theme is "**Mapanuring Paggamit ng Gadget: Tungo sa Mapagkalingang Pamilya at Kapwa**". This emphasizes the critical and responsible use of technology to ensure the development of interactive

communication, interpersonal relations, personal and family, social and civic responsibility.
