

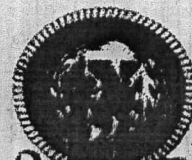

ACTIVITY PROPOSAL

PROJECT TITLE: CONDUCT OF THE DIVISION MENTORING PROGRAM FOR ALS IMPLEMENTERS IN TEACHING NUMERACY

RATIONALE:

Along with the implementation of the K to 12 Basic Education Curriculum for the Alternative Learning System (ALS- K TO 12), Learning Strand 3 caters the development of Mathematical and Problem Solving Skills.

Mathematical and Problem Solving Skills focus on Scientific literacy and numeracy skills which are basic to meaningful participation in community and improving of life of the people, the community, and the country as a whole.

Learning Strand 3 is intended to develop in 17 years old and older out of school youth and adult skills that include core competencies of scientific literacy and numeracy. Integrated across scientific and numeracy literacy skills are the critical functional competencies of openness to change awareness of options, ability to make critical and informed decisions, curiosity, inventiveness and creativity scientific thinking, logical reasoning, spatial intelligence, and future orientation. These competencies specifically seek to extend and refine learner's critical and creative thinking processes.

The ultimate goal of Learning Strand 3 is to develop individuals who are aware of their own thinking, able to make critical and informed decisions, defend their ideas and evaluate the ideas of others, and are persistent in striving for new ways to solve problems. Through the development of such critical thinking, and problem-solving skills, ALS learners will enhance their own personal and social effectiveness by way of improving the quality of life.

To further develop ALS Teachers on content mastery and pedagogy in teaching Mathematical and Problem Solving Skills hence a Division Mentoring Program in Teaching Numeracy Skills for ALS Implementers is hereby proposed.

OBJECTIVES:

This activity aims to:

1. Provide ALS Teachers the learning experiences to master math content and opportunities to engage in appropriate pedagogy to deliver meaningful learning of mathematical and problem solving skills, and
2. To engage ALS Teachers through mentoring to develop positive attitude towards mathematics through collaboration.

EXPECTED OUTPUTS:

1. Documentation of products and performances of the participants
2. Lesson exemplars
3. Teaching and learning materials
4. Assessment tools
5. Contextualized ALS modules in math




