SUBJECT : **OBSERVANCE OF FILIPINO VALUES MONTH (FVM)**

1. The declaration of **November as the Filipino Values Month** was through Proclamation No. 479 dated October 25, 1994 in consonance with the Moral Recovery Program (Proclamation 62 dated September 30, 1992). The objectives are to strengthen the Filipino culture, values and ideals that are pro-God, pro-people, pro-country and pro-nature, and mobilize all Filipinos for nation-building through the practical exercise of human values in daily lives as citizens and to awaken us all to the power of these values in achieving individual and national goals (Proclamation 479, Paragraph 1).
 2. In consonance with these mandates and Unnumbered Regional Memorandum dated October 17, 2019, this division encourages all public and private schools to hold meaningful activities for learners, teaching and non-teaching personnel, parents and other stakeholders. Guided by this year's theme, "**Pamilyang Pilipino Patatagin: Susi sa Paghubog ng Kabataang Maka-Diyos, Makatao, Makakalikasan at Makabansa**", activities would include but are not limited to the following: display of streamers, family day, symposia, film showing, family life-story composition, family tree poster presentation, family slogan contest, pre-marriage fora for teaching and non-teaching personnel, talks on the vocation to marriage for the youth, family counseling, brochure distribution and Filipino family in crises moral and spiritual formation. Other division-level activities will be sent through a different memorandum.
- It is reiterated that in the conduct of such activities, the policy on time-on-task must be strictly adhered to.
