- As part of the activities cited in Division Memorandum 388, s. 2019, this division is holding the **Patiribayan sa Esp Cum Pre-Marriage Forum in Observance of the Filipino Values Month Celebration** on November 28, 2019 in a venue to be announced later.
- This activity shall revolve on this year's theme: **"Pamilyang Pilipino Patatagin: Susi sa Paghubog ng Kabataang Maka-Diyos, Makatao, Makalikasan at Makabansa"**.
- The participants to the Pre-Marriage Forum are the following:
  - 1 single teacher (regardless whether male or female) from every school for high school
  - 1 single teacher (regardless whether male or female) from every district for elementary
- Enclosed is the schedule of activities. Likewise, attached are the contest guidelines, criteria for judging and other details. It is reiterated that in the conduct of such activities during the elimination rounds, the policy on time-on-task must be strictly adhered to as much as possible.
- The forum shall be done in the morning while the Patiribayan in the afternoon on the same venue. Participants in the forum will still witness the contest in the afternoon.
- Expenses relative to the conduct of the activities shall be charged to division HRTD funds (CID-EsP) while travel and other incidental expenses are chargeable to respective school MOOE and/or other funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

**CONTEST GUIDELINES**

**A. EXTEMPORANEOUS SPEAKING**

1. The contest is open to all public **elementary** school pupils. Each **municipality** shall send 1 (one) contestant only with 1 coach.
2. The language to be used is **Filipino**. However, technical terms may not be translated to Filipino anymore.
3. No props are allowed. The contestants shall wear their **School uniform**.
4. All topics to be drawn will revolve on the theme of this year's Filipino Values Month, "*Pamilyang Pilipino Patatagin: Susi sa Paghubog ng Kabataang Maka-Diyos, Makatao, Makakalikasan at Makabansa*".

5. Mechanics of the contest:
  - a. 15 minutes before the contest proper, the contestants will be oriented in a separate room and informed of all the titles/topics prepared by the EPS in-charge in Esp. Cellphones or other means of communication and writing materials are NOT allowed.
  - b. The contestants shall **draw lots** to determine the order of delivery of speeches from the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> up to the last.
  - c. Once the contestant is called, he/she will draw a topic, read it aloud twice and deliver the extemporaneous speech for a **minimum of 3 minutes to a maximum of 4 minutes**. Points shall be deducted from the total score should there be under/overtime following the point system:
 

i. 1-30 seconds	:	1 point
ii. 31 seconds to 1 minute	:	2 points
iii. 1 minute and 1 second or higher	:	3 points
6. Criteria for judging:
 

Content	:	40%
Delivery (posture, gesture, projection)	:	30%
Organization of Ideas	:	30%
Total	:	100%
7. Winners shall be adjudged as:
  - a. Champion (with trophy and certificate)
  - b. First Runner-up (with trophy and certificate)
  - c. Second Runner-up (with trophy and certificate)
  - d. Non-winners (with certificate of participation)
8. Judges' decision is final and irrevocable.

## B. SPOKEN WORD POETRY

1. The contest is open to all public Junior OR Senior **High School** student. Each **municipality** shall send 1 (one) contestant only with 1 coach.
2. The piece should be in **Filipino**. However, technical terms may not be translated to Filipino anymore. It should consider the intellectual property rights; thus, the piece should be **original**. For judging of content, 5 copies shall be distributed ahead of time (preferably on the morning of the contest day).
3. **Costumes and/or props** should be appropriate to the theme.
4. Vulgar, harsh and other inappropriate words are **not** allowed.
5. Use of **background music** is allowed.

6. The spoken word poetry will revolve on the theme of this year's Filipino Values Month, "Pamilyang Pilipino Patatagin: Susi sa Paghubog ng *Kabataang Maka-Diyos, Makatao, Makakalikasan at Makabansa*".
7. Delivery of the piece should last for **4 to 6 minutes** only. Points shall be deducted from the total score should there be under/overtime following the point system:
- i. 1-30 seconds : 1 point
  - ii. 31 seconds to 1 minute : 2 points
  - iii. 1 minute and 1 second or higher : 3 points
8. Drawing of lots will be done before the contest proper.
9. Criteria for judging:

Content and Message	40%
Presentation	50%
▪ <i>Voice Quality</i>	10%
▪ <i>Pronunciation</i>	10%
▪ <i>Enunciation</i>	10%
▪ <i>Articulation</i>	10%
▪ <i>Facial Expression</i>	10%
Costume/Props	10%

- a. Champion (with trophy and certificate)
  - b. First Runner-up (with trophy and certificate)
  - c. Second Runner-up (with trophy and certificate)
  - d. Non-winners (with certificate of participation)
