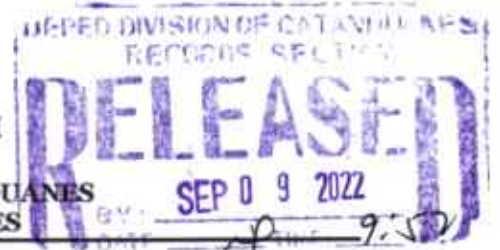

Pursuant to DO 34 s.2022 otherwise known as the **School Calendar and Activities for SY 2022-2023** and OASYASC unnumbered Memorandum dated August 12, 2022, **Interim Guidelines of the Youth Commission on Elections and Appointments (Youth COMEA) for SY 2022-2023 only**, this office informs the field of the said policy for the implementation in all public schools under the coverage relative to the conduct of the Election of Officers of the Supreme Pupil Government (SPG) and Supreme Student Government (SSG) and other School Clubs and Organizations for SY 2022-2023. October 16, 2022	Division Federation of YES- Organization (YES-O) Barkada Kontra Droga (BKD)

2. Please refer to the existing D.O.14 s. 2014, Constitution and By-Laws as to qualifications of officers, while the official set of officers we will make use the interim guidelines of Youth Commission on Elections and Appointments (Youth Comea) for School Year 2022- 2023.
3. After the conduct of the SPG/SSG elections, the schedule of the conduct of elections for other student-led organizations such as Barkada Kontra Droga (BKD), Youth For Environment in Schools' Organization (YES-O) and other registered school clubs and organizations shall commence.
4. School Organization advisers/district advisers are advised to submit an Election report on or before September 16, 2022 not later than 5 pm while District Federation Election report on September 16, 2022, not later than 5 pm. via <https://bit.ly/3KAbjP>.
5. Expenses incurred in the conduct of the SY 2022-2023 student organizations' election shall be charged to School MOOE or other available funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.



Relative to the issued Memorandum titled "Reschedule of the conduct of Trainings, Workshops, Seminars, and participation to Meetings and other Engagements that will require officials and employees to leave their work stations" dated 22 August 2022, the Office of the Assistant Secretary for Youth Affairs and Special Concerns-Youth Formation Division (OASYASC-YFD), respectfully reiterates that the EduAksyon: SPG/SSG Elections Field Monitoring and Evaluation will push through on 12-16 September 2022.

The abovementioned activity is related to the conduct of the SPG/SSG elections in schools, from 1-16 September, which is stipulated in DepEd Order No. 34 s. 2022 titled "School Calendar and Activities for the School Year 2022-2023".
