To: Schools Division Superintendents

In relation to the Training-Workshop on Multi-Media Production for Television and Video-Based Instruction on October 11-17, 2021 at Sarung Banggi Resort Sto. Domingo Albay, the participants are advised of the following:

- Check in of the training team is morning of October 11, 2021 while ingress of participants will be in the afternoon of October 12, 2021 for assignment of rooms, preliminary and orientation activities.
- The workshop will be a strictly live-in/lock-in activity. No participant will be allowed to leave the venue until the last day of the workshop. Wearing of face masks, distancing and other required health protocols will be observed and closely monitored.
- Identified participants are requested to register online prior to the conduct of the trainingworkshop. Upon check-in they will be required to present a negative result of COVID 19 rapid test done not earlier than 24 hours before arrival at the venue. - 4. Aside from the laptop which will be used for editing, laptops may be brought for encoding of scripts and other workshop activities. Additional materials to be brought by each team are chroma cloth, extension wire and mobile internet device which will be used in case internet connectivity in the venue fails.
- 5. Grade levels, learning areas and competencies are assigned per SDO so that participants can prepare and bring the needed materials i.e. textbooks, SLMs, references, etc. for the writing of scripts and production of the tv-video-based lessons. Assignment per SDO team is found in the enclosure.
- A supervisor from the Curriculum Implementation Division must be assigned to assist the team in their preparations for the workshop.
- 7. Expenses for the rapid test, purchase of expendable supplies and other related expenses for the team's participation in the workshop may be charged against funds for provision of learning resources downloaded to SDOs/local funds/SEF and other sources subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
