Date: **February 11, 2019**

1. Pursuant to DepEd Memorandum No. 006, s.2019, entitled 2018 Accreditation and Equivalency (A&E) Test Registration and Administration, the Department of Education (DepEd), through the Bureau of Education Assessment (BEA) and this Office, shall administer the **Accreditation and Equivalency (A&E) Test for 2018 on February 24, 2019 at designated testing centers**. Since February 24 falls on a Sunday, a one (1) day Service Credit and Compensatory Overtime Credit shall be given to those involve in the administration of the A & E test.
2. The following may take the test:
 - a. Learners in the Alternative Learning System (ALS) and Non-Formal Education programs;
 - b. Out-of-School children and youth who are prepared for assessment; and
 - c. Adults who are seeking Certification of Learning.
3. Only the registered applicants with complete requirements shall be allowed to take the test during the scheduled dates.

4. In compliance with DepEd Memorandum No. 121, s. 2017, portfolio assessment will not be required for the 2018 A & E Test and it will not be a part of the final rating. Hence, the test is multiple-choice type only. The passing rate is still 60% as provided in DM No. 76, s. 2018.
5. To ensure proper and standardized test administration, a **Division Orientation-Conference will be conducted on February 15, 2019, 1:00 o'clock in the afternoon at SDO- SGOD Office.**
6. Authorized to attend the Orientation-Conference are the Division Testing Coordinator, Registration Officers, Room Examiners, Room Supervisors and Chief Examiners of testing centers.
7. Attached is the List of Chief Examiners, Room Supervisors, Room Examiners and Testing Center in the conduct of (A&E) Test. They are enjoined to report to their respective assigned testing centers on or before 7:00 o'clock in the morning of February 24, 2019
