FOR TEACHERS (MT4T)

- 1. In relation to the Learning Action Cell as a K to 12 Education Program School-Based Continuing Professional Development Strategy for the Improvement of Teaching and Learning (DepEd Order No. 35, s. 2016) and Utilization of Mobile Technology for Teachers (OM-OAGA-2021-0096), this Division announces the conduct of Virtual/Face to Face LAC Session on Mobile Technology for Teachers (MT4T) from November 2021 to December 2021.
