### DIVISION TRAINING-WORKSHOP FOR SPED AND RECEIVING TEACHERS ON THE USE OF SPED CURRICULA FOR LEARNERS WITH DISABILITIES DURING CRISIS SITUATIONS

- 1. As part of the initiatives of the Department of Education on the Provision of Educational Programs and Services to Learners with Disabilities, as per DepEd Order No. 44, s. 2021 and in support of the goal of sustaining delivery of quality and accessible, relevant and liberating education services to diverse learners, a Division Training-Workshop for SPED and Receiving Teachers on the Use of SPED Curricula for LWDs during Crisis Situations shall be held on December 1-3, 2021 at a venue to be announced later.
