The 30th NCM's focus and theme for this year tackles the mental health and well-being of children. It aims to uncover how mental health cuts across children's rights to survival, development, protection, and participation, and how we can collectively call for actionable changes crucial to children's overall well-being. Thus, with the objective of strengthening and promoting the rights of the child, quality education, and care for learner's overall health and well-being, the Summit's theme centers on three (3) important concepts, namely *Karapatan* (Rights in Education), *Kalidad* (Quality in Education), and *Kalinga* (Care in Education). Likewise, as with the previous Summits, there will be a **Pre-Summit** Conference for Learners on November 19, 2022 to clicit the learners' views and suggestions on the Summit design and to prepare them for participation and involvement in the Summit.
