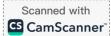

Given the vast effect of Tropical Storm Kristine to DepEd schools in Luzon, the Department will be implementing the use of Central Visayan Institute Foundation-Dynamic Learning Program (CVIF-DLP) Learner Activity Sheets in affected schools as part of Alternative Delivery Modes that can be utilized to minimize learning loss.

The implementation of the CVIF-DLP is meant to be used for the following possible purposes:

- To use in the conduct of make-up classes where the Learner Activity Sheets
 may be utilized to maximize teachers and to optimize instruction time.
- To use in the conduct of remote classes where applicable, wherein Learner Activity Sheets may be provided digitally or physically to students for eventual collection and checking.
- To use in the conduct of classes in Temporary Learning Spaces in schools, while damaged classrooms are undergoing repair and rehabilitation wherein Learner Activity Sheets will be utilized for most of the week

Based on the discussion with the Regional Directors of Region I, II, III, IV-A, V, and CAR, the CVIF-DLP will be initially implemented in select schools to be determined by the Regional and Schools Division Offices. In line with this, an Orientation on the Dynamic Learning Program shall be conducted on November 7, and on November 8, 2024. The schedules are as follows:
