DIVISION SEARCH FOR THE BEST INTEGRATION OF FINANCIAL LITERACY KEY CONCEPTS IN SCIENCE AND MATHEMATICS THROUGH SELF-LEARNING MODULES

- 1. Anent to DepEd Memorandum No. 83 s. 2021, re: Search for the Best Integration of Financial Literacy Key Concepts in Science and Mathematics through Self-Learning Modules and Regional Memorandum No. 147 s. 2021, re: Regional Search for Search for the Best Integration of Financial Literacy Key Concepts in Science and Mathematics through Self-Learning Modules, this office through the Curriculum Implementation Division shall conduct the Division Search for the Best SLM's with the Best Integration of Financial Literacy in Science and Mathematics on January 3-7, 2022.
- 2. The Division Search for the Best Integration of Financial Literacy Key Concepts in Science and Mathematics through Self-Learning Modules is an SLM writing competition for teachers on developing creative and innovative self-learning modules (SLMs) that best integrate financial literacy concepts in Science and Mathematics.
- 3. The following are the categories:

4. The SLM must be aligned with the most essential leaning competencies (MELCs) in Science and Mathematics of the K to 12 Curriculum. The coverage of the lessons will



be from first to fourth quarter of Grade 4 to Grade 6 for elementary and Grade 7 to Grade 10 for Junior High School.

- 5. Deadline of submission is on or before January 7, 2022 to ninogerard.ceneta@deped.gov.ph for Science and jezrahcl.omadto@deped.gov.ph for Mathematics. Strict adherence to competition mechanics must be observed. The top winners for each category shall be endorsed by the regional office to the national level competition.

SEARCH FOR THE BEST INTEGRATION OF FINANCIAL LITERACY KEY CONCEPTSIN SCIENCE AND MATHEMATICS THROUGH SELF-LEARNING MODULES

- 1. There shall be four (4) categories:
 - a. SLMs in Mathematics for Elementary
 - b. SLMs in Mathematics for Junior High School
 - c. SLMs in Science for Elementary
 - d. SLMs in Science for Junior High School
- 2. The SLMs must be aligned with the most essential learning competencies (MELCs) in Science or Mathematics of the K to 12 Curriculum. The coverage of the lessons will be anywhere from first to fourth quarter of Grade 4 to Grade 6 for elementary and Grade 7 to Grade 10 for the junior high school.
- 3. The SLMs may also include the financial literacy training videos by BDO Foundation, Inc, which is made available through the DepEd Portal.
- 4. Entries should be written in English being the medium of instruction of the learning area.
- 5. The SDO through the Science and Mathematics Supervisor must ensure that the entries are compliant with the requirement as identified in the checklist in Enclosure 4.
- 6. Maximum of two teachers may collaborate on the SLM. Teacher-participants must be teaching Math or Science for at least three (3) years. Teacher-writers for the junior high school level should have a specialization in Science or Math or is a graduate of Math/ Science-related courses.
- 7. Entries must be received not later than **January 7**, **2022**. Science and Math supervisors shall send all required documents to ninogerard.ceneta@deped.gov.ph for Science and jezrahel.omadto@deped.gov.ph for Math.
- 8. Entries received after the deadline will no longer be evaluated. Files must be saved in PDF version following this file format:

SLM_Level_Learning Area_District/School Name_Last Name, e.g. SLM_Elementary_Mathematics_CNHS_Cruz

- 9. Among the required documents to be submitted are as follows:
 - a. Scanned endorsement from District/School
 - b. Notarized Certification (Enclosure 2)
 - c. Writer's Declaration of Warranties Form with Declaration (Enclosure 3)
 - d. Bionote of the teacher-writer/s



- e. Checklist of the submitted requirements signed by the learning resource evaluator (LRE) of the region (Enclosure 4)
- 10.An entry found to be copied or imitated will mean disqualification from the competition. Intellectual property of the submitted SLMs shall be owned by the proponent/s. Permission will be given to DepEd to allow reproduction of the SLMs, at no cost to DepEd and regardless of the number of copies perpetually, for future use by other teachers.
- 11. There will be a separate set of evaluators/judges for each category. A separate guideline on the process of evaluating/judging the entries shall be issued for the judges. The SLMs will be evaluated based on the agreed set of criteria.
