2024 FILIPINO VALUES MONTH CELEBRATION

- 1. November is declared Filipino Values Month pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 479, dated October 25, 1994. This year's theme is "Pagsusulong ng Bagong Pilipinas: Ang Kabataan Bilang Pundasyon ng Pagbabago," a corollary to Regional Memorandum No. 1312, s. 2024. The theme aptly highlights the vital role of our youth in shaping a brighter future for the Philippines.
- 2. Hence, they should be encouraged to:
 - a) embrace and practice Filipino values by fostering a deeper understanding and appreciation of our rich cultural heritage and its core values, such as *katatagan*, *katapatan*, *kabaitan*, pakamatulungin, and *pagiging responsable*;
 - develop leadership skills by empowering our youth to become responsible citizens and future leaders equipped with the skills and knowledge necessary to contribute to nation-building;
 - c) promote civic engagement by encouraging their active participation in community projects and initiatives that address social issues and contribute to the betterment of our society.
- 3. It is encouraged that all schools develop and implement creative and engaging activities that align with the theme and objectives of the celebration. Some suggested activities include:
 - values-based workshops and seminars focusing on specific Filipino values and their relevance to contemporary issues;
 - competitions and contests which encourage creativity and critical thinking through essay writing, poster-making, and other relevant competitions;

- community outreach programs that organize projects that benefit marginalized communities and demonstrate the spirit of bayanihan;
- cultural performances and exhibits that show Filipino culture's beauty and diversity through traditional dances, songs, and art;
- reading of the weekly value focus after the flag ceremony or before the start of the class;
- values camp that focuses on values formation, socio-emotional learning, and values restoration.
- 4. All schools are required to submit a detailed accomplishment report/completion report on their 2024 Filipino Values Month celebration to marivic.camacho001@deped.gov.ph on or before December 2, 2024. The report should include a summary of activities conducted, key learnings, and impact on students and the community.
- 5. The teaching and non-teaching personnel are enjoined to work together to make this year's Filipino Values Month celebration a resounding success, empowering our youth to become agents of positive change and contribute to the progress of our nation.
- 6. Attached to this issuance is the Regional Memorandum for your reference.
- 6. Allowable expenses related to the observance shall be charged to local funds/MOOE adhering to the relevant accounting rules and regulations.



2024 OBSERVANCE OF FILIPINO VALUES MONTH (FVM)

- Presidential Proclamation No. 479 dated October 25, 1994 declares the month of November as Filipino Values Month, in consonance with the Moral Recovery Program (Proclamation No. 62 dated September 30, 1992). The objective of which is to strengthen the Filipino culture, values and ideals that are pro-God, pro-People, pro-Country, and pro-nature, and mobilizing all Filipinos for nation-building through the practical exercise of human values in daily lives as citizens and to awaken us all to the power of these values in achieving individual and national goals.
- This year's theme of Filipino Values Month (November 1-30, 2024) is "Pagsusulong ng Bagong Pilipinas: Ang Kabataan Bilang Pundasyon ng Pagbabago"
- With the present situation of some schools in the region brought by typhoon Kristine, Schools Division Offices and schools are encouraged to hold simple but meaningful activities such as hanging of tarpaulin (for awareness), gift-giving (for typhoon victims), school-wide orientation on Filipino Values, letter writing (to self, parents, teachers, politicians/leaders, etc..) with connection to the theme.
