SEARCH FOR THE OUTSTANDING "BARKADA KONTRA DROGA" (BRD) PROGRAM IMPLEMENTERS IN THE SECONDARY SCHOOLS School Year 2016-2017

I. RATIONALE:

- The Office of the President through the Dangerous Drugs Board issued Board Regulation No. 5, Series of 2007, entitled "Institutionalizing the Barkada Kontra Droga Program". This is in compliance with Section 77, Article IX of RA 9165, otherwise known as the Comprehensive Dangerous Drugs Act of 2002.
- Launching was done and a series of seminars was conducted as a preventive education and information program which evolved into a nationwide "Barkadahan" concept—a collective action among the students and the youth in the community that would strengthen camaraderie; collaboration, cooperation, solidarity and linkages in their commitment to attain a drug-free lifestyle.
- Alternative activities were undertaken after the launching of the program in the schools and in the community such as poster/slogan contests, essay writing contest, among others.
- From 2004 to 2015, 283 BKD Chapters have been organized nationwide with a total membership of 71,271.

II. OBJECTIVES:

A. General:

 Encourage secondary schools to become more actively involved in promoting youth empowerment in leading a healthy lifestyle that is drugfree and productive.

B. Specific:

- Strengthen the National Drug Education Program (NDEP) through the Barkada Kontra Droga mavement established in schools.
- Enhance skills and understanding among students, faculty and school administrators in initiating responses, increasing community awareness and participation in activities geared towards a drug-free school environment.
- Maintain a fully drug free chyllonment in the school, home, workplace and community
- Support and sustain the services like counseling, referral and job placement in the "backing" adopted concepts among educators, professionals, families was dorces, paer groups and other sectors.

All entries for the Medianal Search should be submitted directly to the Depth Central Offices. Deadline for the submission will be on or before July 31, 2017.


. Requirements
