



REGIONAL CELEBRATION OF THE NATIONAL STUDENTS' DAY AND ORIENTATION ON CHILDREN'S RIGHTS

1. Please be informed that this Office, through the Education Support Services Division (ESSD) shall conduct the Regional Celebration of the National Students' Day and Orientation on Children's Rights on November 27-29, 2024, at a venue to be announced later. This is pursuant to Republic Act 11369, An Act Recognizing the Observance of November 17 of Every Year as National Students' Day. This is in observance of International Students' Day, and in recognition of the invaluable contribution of student activism to Philippine democracy for initiating efforts to foster leadership among Filipino students.

2. The activity aims to:

a. recognize the vital role of the youth/students in nation building;

 b. orient and capacitate select officers of the Supreme Elementary/Secondary Learner Government (SELG/SSLG) and Youth Formation Program Coordinators on Children's Rights and child protection issues;

c. strengthen the commitment of Schools Division Offices (SDOs), and schools in the implementation of Student Leadership Development Program; and

d. develop a division/school plan for echo training in their respective divisions and schools.

All participants are requested to register through a link, to be shared later to Division Youth Formation Focal Persons, on or before November 15, 2024, 8:00 am.
