Date : February 27, 2018

1. Anchored on Republic Act 9155 or the Governance of Basic Education Act of 2001 and Republic Act 10533 which give emphasis on the delivery of the culture of research in the education system states that the state shall conserve, promote, popularize the nation's historical and cultural heritage and resources, as well as artistic creations and shall encourage and support researches and studies on the arts and culture studies which will serve as one of the bases for necessary reforms and policy development.

2. In response to this, there will be a **Qualitative Research Writing for Selected Elementary, Junior and Senior High School Teachers on April 10-12, 2018** at a venue to be announced later.

3. This training on research writing aims to:

- familiarize the participants with the practices and trends in conducting qualitative research;
- develop the participants competence and confidence in qualitative research writing and mentoring;
- increase participants' awareness on the richness of Catanduanan heritage that could serve as inexhaustible source of materials for qualitative research;
- craft sample research topics observing the concepts learned; and
- exhibit gained knowledge and sense of persistence through meaningful output presentation.

4. Registration fee of **One Thousand Fifty Pesos (P1, 050.00)** per participant shall be borne from the school MOOE to cover meals, accommodation, training kits, supplies and materials.

5. Transportation and other incidental expenses of participants shall be charged against school MOOE subject to the usual auditing rules and regulations.
