DIVISION MEMORANDUM

No. 264, s. 2018

DIVISION ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS PRESS CONFERENCE

To: Public Schools District Supervisors
Elementary School Heads

1. Pursuant to Republic Act No. 7079, otherwise known as the Campus Journalism Act of 1991, the Schools Division Office of Catanduanes through the Catanduanes Association of Elementary School Paper Advisers (CAESPA), announces the conduct of Division Elementary Schools Press Conference at Taytay Elementary School on October 14-16, 2018.
2. This year's theme is: "Fostering 21st Century Skills and Character-Based Education through Campus Journalism."
3. The activity aims to:
 - a. Demonstrate understanding of the importance of journalism by expressing it through different journalistic endeavors and approaches;
 - b. Sustain advocacy on social consciousness and environmental awareness;
 - c. Provide avenue for an enriching learning experience for students interested in journalism as a career or those who intend to use skill sets learned through campus journalism to give them a better edge in their careers;
 - d. Promote responsible journalism and fair and ethical media; and,
 - e. Enhance journalistic competence through healthy and friendly competitions.
4. The Conference will focus on the following:
 - a. Individual Contests (English and Filipino)

Editorial Writing	Editorial Cartooning
News Writing	Photojournalism
Feature Writing	Copyreading and Headline Writing
Sports Writing	Science and Health Writing
 - b. Group Contests (English and Filipino)

Radio Script Writing and Broadcasting
Collaborative Desktop Publishing
School Paper Competition

5. Participants to this Conference should come from Grades 4-6. Every pupil is allowed to participate in only one event either individual or group contest. For this year's policy, several coaches from each school are allowed to participate, aside from the two advisers, regardless of grade level provided that there will be only one pupil one coach per individual event and one coach also per group contest in both English and Filipino. All coaches should register and will be given certificate of recognition in case their contestants win in the competition.
6. The implementing guidelines for the individual and group contests stipulated in DepEd Memorandum No. 200, s. 2017 shall be strictly followed.
7. The contestants will not be accommodated in the contest venue due to limited school facilities.
8. Five (5) winners in the individual events and top three (3) for radio script writing and broadcasting and collaborative desktop publishing in both English and Filipino categories shall be declared; however, only the top three (3) in the individual events and the best team for radio script writing and broadcasting and collaborative desktop publishing will represent the Schools Division of Catanduanes in the Regional Schools Press Conference at Camarines Sur National High School in Naga City on November 13-16, 2018.
9. Likewise, the top three (3) winners in the search for Outstanding School Paper Adviser and campus Journalist together with the top ten (10) winners in the school paper contest by section (News Section/Pahinang Balita, Editorial Section/Pahinang Editoryal, Feature Page/Pahinang Lathalain, Sports Section/Pahinang Pampalakasan, Science and Technology Section/Pahinang Agham at Teknolohiya, at Layout and Page Design/Kategoryang Pag-Aanyo at Disenyo ng Pahina shall be declared.
10. The Committee on Registration shall enforce the "No school paper, No contestant" policy. The school paper to be submitted should adhere to the rules concerning plagiarism. No campus publication should be submitted to the Division/Region/National that has copied and published texts, graphics, and other materials without duly acknowledging their sources.
11. All participating schools should submit school paper entries in hard copy.
12. Schools that will join in the school paper contest should submit six (6) printed copies of the DRAFT of their school paper (9" X12" for the elementary) to Dr. Ma. Gina M. Templonuevo on October 9, 2018 (English and Filipino) together with the documents for the search for School Paper Adviser and Campus Journalist. The deadline of submission at the Regional Office is on October 12, 2018.
13. The results of the school paper contest will be announced during the Division Press Conference.
14. The twelve (12) chairpersons of the working committee except the facilitators will have an orientation at the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) on October 12, 2018 at 8:00 a.m.
15. A registration fee of three hundred pesos (PhP300) shall be charged each participant which shall cover the cost of meals and snacks of the working committee and guests, honorarium for speakers, supplies and materials (Division Cliniquing (in part) and other incidental expenses. All expenses relative to the participation in this Conference shall be charged to the school Maintenance and Other Operating Expense (MOOE) /local funds/SEF/Campus Journalism funds, subject to the usual accounting and

auditing rules and procedures. Participants from private schools shall make their own arrangements to source out funds that will cover the costs relative to their participation in the aforementioned activity.

16. The annual membership fee of sixty pesos (Php60) for school paper advisers and thirty pesos (Php30) for pupil-writers shall be paid directly to the CAESPA treasurer, Joji Ordon of Virac Pilot Elementary School. See enclosure No. 1 to this Memorandum.

17. The list of participants to the DESPC should be submitted to maginatemplonuevo@gmail.com on or before October 10, 2018.

18. The schedule of activities and list of Working Committee are found in Enclosures 2-3.

19. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
