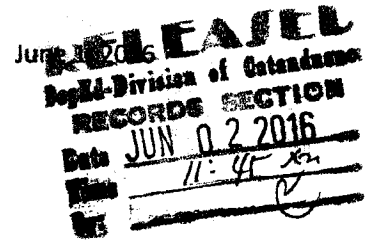

**PROVINCIAL ORIENTATION CONFERENCE ON THE ADMINISTRATION OF  
THE LANGUAGE ASSESSMENT FOR PRIMARY GRADES (LAPG) AND THE  
NATIONAL ACHIEVEMENT TEST (NAT) 2016**

To: Chiefs, CID and SGOD  
Education Program Supervisors (EPSs)  
Public Schools District Supervisors (PSDSs)  
Senior Education Program Specialists (SEPSs)  
Heads, Public and Private Elementary and Secondary Schools  
All others concerned

1. In consonance with DepEd Memoranda Nos. 1 and 26, s. 2016, the Department of Education (DepEd) through the Bureau of Education Assessment, shall administer the Language Assessment for Primary Grades (LAPG) and the National Achievement Test 2016 nationwide as contained in DepEd Memorandum No. 26, s. 2016 on the following dates:
  - a. June 15, 2016 – All Grade Four learners in all public schools nationwide
  - b. June 17, 2016 – All Grade Seven learners in all public and private schools nationwide
  - c. June 23, 2016 – Selected Grade 11 learners in selected public and private secondary schools nationwide
2. Only private schools with DepEd- issued permit shall be included in the conduct of the test. Each NAT examinee shall be issued a Certificate of Rating (COR) containing the actual rating per subject area.
3. All test takers shall indicate in their respective answer sheets the schools where they completed their **Grades Three, Six and Ten Curricula**.
4. In view of these testing activities, this Division shall conduct the Provincial Orientation Conference on the NAT and LAPG Standardized Administration on **June 8, 2016** at **DepEd Division Office Conference Hall A**. Elementary group shall report at 8:00- 12:00 in the morning while the secondary school heads at 1:00- 5:00 in the afternoon.
5. Authorized to attend this Orientation Conference are the Chiefs, EPSs, PSDSs and Heads of every Elementary and Secondary Schools. The School Testing Coordinator shall represent the school head in their absence.

6. Updated number of enrolment of every school shall be submitted on or before the Orientation date in a short bond paper for the allocation of the number of examiners.
7. Travel and other allowable expenses in attending this orientation are chargeable against local/school MOOE or other funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Snack and meals shall not be served.
8. Immediate dissemination of and strict compliance to this Memorandum is desired.
