DIVISION LEARNING ACTION CELLS (DLAC) FOR SECONDARY SCIENCE TEACHERS

To: **Secondary School Heads**

1. Cognizant to DepEd Order No. 35, s. 2016 entitled "The Learning Action Cell as a K to 12 Basic Education Program School-Based Continuing Professional Development Strategy for the Improvement of Teaching and Learning" a Division Learning Action Cell (DLAC) for Secondary Schools Science and Technology Teachers will be conducted one (1) Saturday every month starting October 15, 2016 until March, 2017.
2. The DLAC aims to:
 - 2.1 Function as a Professional Learning Community for Secondary Science Teachers that will help them improve practice and learner achievement.
 - 2.2 Provide Professional Learning teams (PLT) in Schools to meet once a month to share and reinforce the learning in the PLT.
